

Business Concerns Up 3.4 Per Cent In Past Two Years

Business concerns in Roseburg increased by more than 3.4 per cent between 1954 and 1956, reports J. Harry White, district manager of the Portland office of Dun & Bradstreet.

He made the report based on figures carried in the 1956 reference book completed in November. The book shows Roseburg now has 492 enterprises, compared to 478 in 1954.

The reference book, incidentally, lists only manufacturers, wholesalers, retailers and some service companies, such as laundries and gasoline service stations. Thus, the total number of businesses in Roseburg as well as the rest of the country is actually higher than the figures quoted.

The number of businesses in other major towns of the county are: Myrtle Creek, 85; Reedsport, 60; Sutherlin, 41 and Trout, 37.

Social Security Taxes Will Increase Tuesday

WASHINGTON 28—Social Security taxes go up Tuesday—to affect some \$10 million persons during 1957.

They also will begin to apply for the first time to members of the armed services.

The rate for covered workers and their employers will rise from 2 per cent to 2 1/4 per cent for each, or from a total of 4 per cent to 4 1/2 per cent. This is maintained to apply to about \$1 million persons over the course of the year 1957.

For about 6 1/2 million self-employed persons covered by old age and survivors insurance the rate goes up from 3 per cent to 3 1/4 per cent.

The taxes apply to the first \$3,000 of annual income.

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Contract Extended For Carl Jacobson

A contract extension has been granted Carl Jacobson of Lakeside by the Douglas County Court, extending Jacobson's timber cutting rights on a 40-acre plot of land located on Smith River, until March 1958.

The land is located about five miles up Smith River from Reedsport and contains some of the finest old growth Douglas fir and spruce in the county, according to County Land Agent Bob Kischei.

Plans call for Jacobson to replant the area with Douglas fir or other available coniferous planting stock, 600 seedlings to the acre. By this planting, it is expected that the fast encroachment of brush characteristic of the coastal area will be arrested.

In exchange for allowing Jacobson more time to properly market this timber, he has posted a cashier's check guaranteeing to cover the costs of replanting within two years of harvesting the timber.

According to Kischei, foresters unanimously recognize this practice as correct procedure, provided all merchantable timber is removed when the area is logged.

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Vice President's Fast Scram Fails Robbery Of Bank

PAUL VALLEY, Okla. 28—An attempted robbery of the First National Bank of Paul Valley, Okla., by two armed men wearing halloween masks was foiled early Monday when the bank's vice president made a quick getaway through a side door and notified officers.

A. M. Foss, vice president and cashier of the bank, said one of the men held a gun at his back and told him to open up the vault.

"I made out like I was going over to the vault in the back and then I got outside through a side door before the robbers knew what I was doing," Foss said. "I guess it was just my lucky day."
