

Seven Rescued In Boat Mishaps Near Bandon

BANDON — A strong ebb tide caught an 18-foot boat in the Coquille River Sunday and a huge wave at the river bar overturned it, spilling its two occupants into the chill water.

Both were rescued, though, and a Coast Guard boat on the way to help them picked up a sports fishing boat drifting helplessly toward heavy seas with five aboard.

In the first boat were John Boyd Duncan, route 1, Coos Bay, and Roger Lee Jewell, Coquille. Not only did their boat overturn, but it kept right on going and finished upright with the outboard motor still running. Duncan and

Jewell, though, were in the water, clinging to the side of the boat. Before the Coast Guard reached them, the tug Port of Bandon picked up the two and the Coast Guard then spotted the sports fishing boat, with its engine silent, drifting into the heavy seas. It reached the boat and its five occupants before they were in serious danger.

Oregon Forest Products Lab Contract Awarded

CORVALLIS — A contract was let Monday for construction of a building here to house the Oregon Forest Products Laboratory and the Forest Lands Research Agency.

It will be an all-wood building with only the concrete slab on which it is to be erected having an appreciable amount of other material.

Winning bidder was John Steinmiller Jr., Eugene, on his offer of \$403,073. There were five other bids.

The building will provide 40,000 square feet of floor space. It will be located at the western edge of Corvallis.

The research office is being moved here from Salem to occupy the building.

The new contract runs through May, 1960, and establishes the general industry wage rates. Minimum is \$1.98 an hour, Whalen said.

The plants are those of Fir-Tex Insulating Board, Inc., and Western Insulated Products, Inc. Their properties include 16,000 acres of timberland in Oregon and Washington. Kaiser bought the plants nine weeks ago.

Kaiser Gypsum, Ex-Strikers Sign Labor Contract

PORTLAND — A three-year labor contract was signed Monday for the Kaiser Gypsum Co.'s insulating board plants at St. Helens, Ore., which, before Kaiser bought them, were struck for 19 months by the Lumber and Sawmill Workers Union.

The plants, then owned by Dant & Russell, continued operation after the strike, recruiting non-union workers. In the course of the strike, over confused issues in contract renewal, the state sought vainly to bring peace.

James M. Whallon of the Columbia District Council of the union, said Monday that Kaiser had hired "a good many" of the men who had gone on strike and was expected to re-employ most of these still available when more shifts are added later in the year.

The plants now have 164 workers and use up to 410 when on a 24-hour basis, he said.
