

Wealthy Youth Still Determined To Marry Cook

SAN FRANCISCO — William Wallace Mein III, almost 21, whose socialite mother asked superior courts a month ago to dissolve his marriage to the family cook, has enlisted in the Marine Corps.

It turned out that the court action by Mrs. William Wallace Mein Jr. was premature—young Mein and Isolda Constantini, 24-year-old German immigrant, had not been married.

But he is still determined to marry the girl, the family attorney said Monday night. Colin Peters of Palo Alto said Mein's decision to enlist merely has resulted in a "temporary postponement of the wedding plans."

He will be 21 next month and free to marry as he pleases.

Mein, who has just completed the first half of his junior year at the University of California, will leave Friday for boot camp in San Diego.

His mother is an heir to the fortune left by her great-grandfather, California cattle baron Henry Miller. Mein's father is president of both the Calaveras Cement Co. and the Bishop Oil Co.

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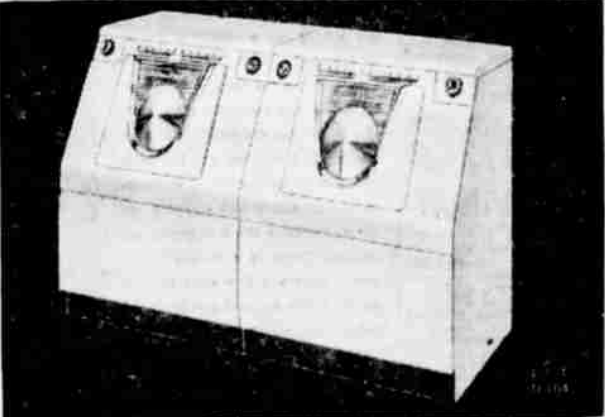
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Explosion Kills Seven, Injures Nine In Illinois

ROSELLE, Ill. — Authorities investigated the shattered ruins of a two-story brick hardware store-apartment building which exploded and burned Monday, killing seven persons and injuring nine others.

The nighttime blast and flash fire, which police said apparently was caused by leaking gas, littered rubble through the business section of this northern Illinois town of 1,000.

Police said they believed all the victims were in the store when the explosion occurred. The injured were in nearby shops or on the sidewalk fronting the building.

The dead were listed as Herbert Gieseke, 49, operator of the hardware store; Mrs. Evelyn Kramp, 41, and Donald Willie, 21, store
