Man Who Knew Lincoln, Wild Bill Is Now 100

SAN DIEGO, Calif. — A man who authorities said kept promoting himself in the Navy without joining it was under federal grand jury indictment Friday.

Assistant U.S. Dist. Atty. Harry Steward said Joseph Henry Simon, 40, was impersonating a lieutenant commander when arrested in Portland, Ore., and was wearing a uniform he bought here on credit.

Steward said Simon had been arrested five times for such impersonation and each time his Navy rank had advanced. He used 15 aliases, Steward said.

U.S. Chinese Delegates Hold 66th Conference

GENEVA — Ambassadors U. Alexis Johnson of the United States and Wang Ping-nan of Communist China held their 66th meeting here Thursday and agreed to meet again April 11.

The 29-month-old secret talks have been deadlocked since last summer. The ambassadors now meet only once a month, mainly to restate their positions.

Johnson is trying to negotiate the release of nine Americans imprisoned in China and to get Red China to renounce the use of force against Nationalist-held Formosa.
