A total volume of 275,000 board feet of timber appraised at \$2,825.00 was sold. Also, 225,000 board feet of Douglas fir and pine appraised at \$28.00 per thousand board feet; 20,000 board feet of Western hemlock and other species

John Tilly of Sutherland was the high bidder at \$8,630. His bid was \$30 per thousand board feet on the Douglas fir and pine and \$22 per thousand board feet on the Western hemlock and other species.

Jim and Gene Logging Co. of Sutherland and the Hansen Lumber Co. of Glade also bid.
