'Name The Page' Contest Open Only One Week Longer

High schoolers of Douglas County have only one more week to enter the "name the page" contest being sponsored by The News-Review.

The contest will end next Monday. Meanwhile, the field is wide open for the cash prizes being offered for the best three names in the contest. The winner of the contest to name the section of each Monday's News-Review devoted to teen-age activities will win \$10. Second and third place winners will receive \$7.50 and \$5, respectively. The rules are simple. Any high school student in the county may enter merely by choosing his suggested name for the page and writing it on a postcard or in a letter with his full name, address, school class and school attending. It should then be mailed before the April 22 deadline. The suggested name can contain no more than four words. It should be simple and should convey the teen-age character of the section. Neither the words "high school" nor the names of any schools or sections of the county should be used, since the section is county-wide in character. 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Boys Preparing For YMCA Summer Camp Scheduled At Diamond Lake

Fifteen boys have filed applications for YMCA summer camp and forms are coming into the "Y" office every day. Don Naden, YMCA executive secretary, said.

About ten boys are earning their camp fee by selling soap. Donald Blackwell, son of Mr. and Mrs. Robert Blackwell, 1529 SE Harvard Ave. was the first boy to earn his entire camp fee of \$22. By the time camp starts, between 30 and 35 boys are expected to be earning their fee by selling soap. Naden said. He emphasized, however, that selling the soap is not a prerequisite to going to camp.

Application forms for camp and the soap may be picked up at the YMCA office, 520 Spruce St., Rose and Riverside elementary schools, Flegel Transfer and Storage Co. and the Mid-Oregon Printing and Stationery Co. An application fee of \$5 must be paid when the forms are picked up. This is applied towards the \$22 total camp fee.

The summer camp, which is at Diamond Lake, will be held in two sessions, the first one, July 14 to 20, and the second, July 21 to 27. Sixty boys from Douglas County can attend each session. Parents must provide transportation for their boy to and from the camp.

Health Exam Required
Parents must have their boy at the camp by 2 p.m. on the starting day and can pick the youth up at 2 p.m. the last day of camp. A prerequisite to attending camp is a health examination by the family doctor, Naden said. The examination forms will be sent, by mail, to parents, one week before the youth is scheduled to leave for camp.

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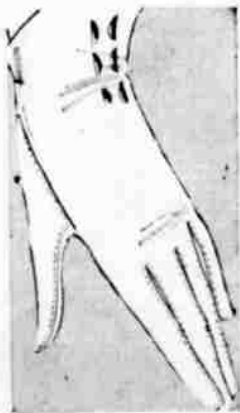
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
