Switzerland Forces French Agent's Recall

BERN, Switzerland (AP) — Col. Marcel Mercier, chief of French intelligence services in Switzerland, has been ordered home at the Swiss government's request.

Mercier was accused of buying secret recordings of Egyptian embassy telephone conversations from Swiss Police Inspector Max Ulrich, now under arrest.

The information thus obtained is believed to have led to the arrest of numerous Algerian nationalist leaders in Algeria and France. Atty. Gen. Rene Duhois committed suicide March 23, after his department was implicated in the dealings with Mercier.

NO RECONCILIATION

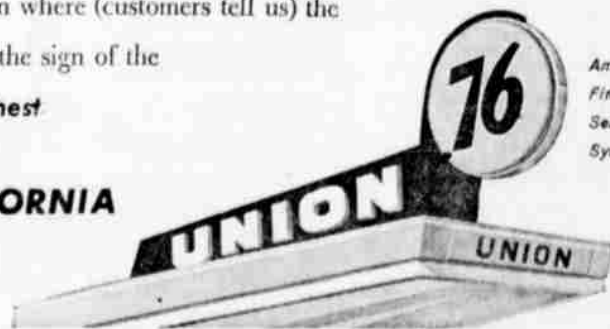
MEXICO CITY (AP) — Actor Tyrone Power says there is no reconciliation in the works for him and his former wife, Linda Christian.
