

Russians Claim Huge H-Bomb

WARSAW — An H-bomb so big that it defies testing reportedly is claimed by the Soviet Union. Poland's semi-official Publicity Information Agency (API) reported Soviet Communist Party boss Khrushchev told a group of visiting Polish journalists about the monster bomb at a meeting in the Kremlin this month, giving these details:

"This bomb is so big we cannot test it even inside the vast area of the Soviet Union. We couldn't even test it in the Arctic. If we set it off at the North Pole it would melt the ice cap and send the oceans spilling over the world."

If the polar icecaps ever thawed, scientists have estimated ocean levels would climb more than 70 feet, flooding London, New York and other low-lying cities. The API correspondent said Khrushchev told the group to expect

Ship Passengers Spreading New Type Influenza

GENEVA, Switzerland — Officials of the United Nations World Health Organization said Friday 300 passengers of a ship which reached Madras from Singapore two weeks ago may now be spreading a new type of influenza virus in India and the Middle East.

The virus was discovered in samples from from Singapore, tested by the World Influenza center in London, the officials said.

The virus is described as an "antigenic variant of type A, differing in several respects from recently isolated strains." It is believed to be responsible for the influenza epidemic now affecting nearly every country in the Western Pacific area. The form of influenza caused by the virus is generally not fatal, though several deaths have been reported from Singapore and Manila.

A ship which landed at Madras from Singapore May 17 had 44 active cases of influenza on board. Reports received by WHO in the past two weeks show that at least 20 per cent of the population of Hong Kong, Formosa, the Philippines, Cambodia, Malaya, Indonesia, Borneo and Singapore have been affected by the disease.

Memorial Day Racing Event Ends In Tragedy

CLARKSON, Pa. — The feature race of a Memorial Day attraction at a nearby Shippensburg speedway ended in tragedy as a wheel flew off a stock car, literally climbed up a protective netting and bounded into a crowd of spectators — killing two children.

Another child and two adults were injured at the Pinegrove Speedway about 90 miles north-east of Pittsburgh. The driver involved, Ted Wise, Hubbard, Ohio, was not hurt.
