

# President Doubts Civil Rights Bill Referendum Subject

WASHINGTON — President Eisenhower said this week he doubts his civil rights program would make a good subject for a referendum even if it could be submitted to a direct vote of the people.

Eisenhower's statement was made in response to news conference questions as to his view on a proposal by Sen. Russell (D-Ga.) that the controversial civil rights bill passed by the House be submitted to a referendum.

Russell proposed that the bill not become effective, even if passed by the Senate, until it is approved by a majority of the nation's voters.

Eisenhower said he does not know of any constitutional provision under which such a question could be submitted to a popular vote. He said issues of this kind should be handled by responsible officials in government.

In any event, Eisenhower said there have been court decisions on the civil rights question and a referendum could have no effect on them.

Sen. Neuberger (D-Ore.), who backs the civil rights bill, told the Senate he would be willing to accept Russell's plebiscite idea and be bound by its results.

# Operation Alert 1957 Is Already Under Way

WASHINGTON — The first phase of Operation Alert 1957 already is under way.

The fourth nationwide civil defense exercise is scheduled to be in full swing in mid-July.

But White House press secretary James C. Hagerty told newsmen that for two weeks, certain key officials have been at work manning and equipping secret relocation centers. From these centers, picked government teams will direct simulated reconstruction and a mock war effort in the wake of an assumed nuclear attack on the United States.

# International Paper Co. Must Sell New Stock

WASHINGTON — The world's largest producer of paper, the International Paper Co. of New York, this week was ordered by the Federal Trade Commission to sell all of its recently-acquired stock in the Longview Fiber Co.

Longview Fiber is one of the West Coast's leading paper manufacturers.

International Paper said it would comply with the FTC order, which also prohibits International Paper from acquiring any interest in any competing firm for 10 years.

In addition, the FTC ordered that at least 40 per cent of the paper and paperboard to be produced at an Oregon plant International proposes to construct be sold to independent, non-integrated wholesalers, converters and other purchasers in the 11 West-ern states.

In a complaint issued last year, the FTC said International's acquisition of the Long-Bell Lumber Co., a holding company, and the Long-Bell Lumber Co. was in violation of the Clayton Anti-Trust Act.

The FTC's order of Tuesday does not require that International dispose of the two concerns but does require that a 12 per cent stock interest which Long-Bell holds in Longview Fiber be sold.

When International enters the West Coast market, Longview Fiber will be a major competitor.

Longview Fiber has plants in Longview, Seattle, Los Angeles and Oakland. Its headquarters are at Longview.

# Neuberger Scores Tobacco Use

WASHINGTON — Sen. Neuberger (D-Ore) here has called on the Department of Health, Education and Welfare to tell the people about "the very grim and direct perils involved in the use of tobacco."

"The wealth of a nation is the health of its people," he said. "Responsible and reliable medical experts now believe that cigarette smoking is injurious to health, that it particularly endangers the lungs, that it may even be a factor in malignancies of the lung. At the American Medical Assn. convention in New York City in June, it was announced that deaths from lung cancer are 1,000 per cent greater among men who smoke cigarettes than among nonsmokers."

"The statistics on the prevalence of lung cancer among inveterate smokers can no longer be disregarded. The time has come for the United States government to warn its people of the very grim and direct perils involved in the use of tobacco."

## Scientists See Link Of Viruses And Cancer

LINDAU, Germany — An American scientist here told Nobel Prize winners from the world over there may be closer links between viruses and cancer than originally assumed.

Prof. Wendell M. Stanley of Berkeley Calif., a Nobel Prize winner in chemistry in 1946, was one of several scientists who lectured on cancer during the second session of the Nobel winners' annual convention. Scientific discussions of all kinds are being discussed in the four-day meeting.

Prof. Stanley said establishment of a closer link between viruses and cancer could open new roads to a final cure.

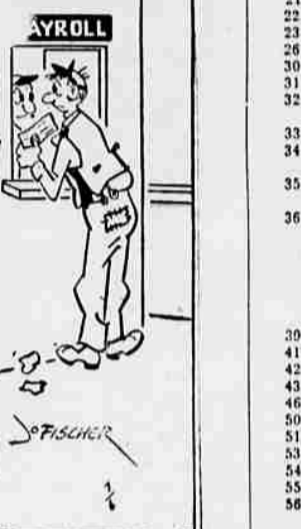

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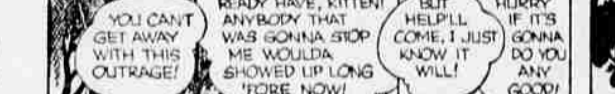
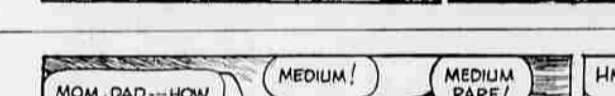
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
