

Aluminum Companies Accused Of Buying Cheaper Canadian Product For U. S. Purchase

WASHINGTON (AP) — Sen. Robertson (D-Va.) said Tuesday major U. S. aluminum companies are asking the government to buy millions of pounds of the metal while

they are importing cheaper Canadian aluminum.

Franklin G. Floete, administrator of the General Services Administration (GSA), confirmed that there is some substance to Robertson's complaint.

At a hearing of the Senate House Committee on Defense Production, Floete said GSA had purchased some 400 million pounds of aluminum from Aluminum Co. of America (ALCOA) and the Kaiser Aluminum Co. under Korean War contracts that soon will expire. The contracts commit the government to buy for the defense stockpile surplus production of aluminum. GSA does the buying.

The GSA chief also said he has worked out tentative agreements with ALCOA and Kaiser to deduct a major portion of their Canadian imports in figuring their surplus production.

Floete said the purchase agreements — made during the Korean War to expand U. S. aluminum production — might require the government to buy some 1,365,818,500 additional pounds of aluminum at a cost of more than \$40 million dollars.

He confirmed Robertson's statement that ALCOA and Kaiser in 1953 made long-term contracts to buy the metal from Aluminum Co. of Canada.

Floete said the Korean contracts are silent as to whether aluminum imports may be included by the U. S. companies in figuring their domestic production which the government is committed to buy.

Floete said he agrees with Robertson that special government tax benefits and purchase agreements were not intended to subsidize aluminum production in Canada.

Mack Pins 'Do Nothing' Label On Congress

WASHINGTON (AP) — Rep. Mack (R-Wash.) pinned the "do nothing" label on this session of Congress Wednesday.

Asserting Congress has done nothing except pass appropriations bills and extend a few laws that were about to expire, Mack declared:

"That this has been a do nothing Congress is largely due to one thing, the fact that the President is of one political party and the House and Senate of the other political party."

In his periodic report to constituents, Mack said the Democratic Congress, "fearing the President and the Republicans will get the credit if Eisenhower programs are adopted, has refused to act upon his proposals and if it acts scuttles the President's program by crippling amendments."

Helicopter Off On Mercy Trip

WENATCHEE (AP) — A Coast Guard helicopter left here Wednesday on a mercy mission to a remote pass high in the northern Cascades where a member of a mountaineering party was reported in a diabetic coma.

The name, age and hometown of the gravely ill man were not known.

A doctor with the party got out word of the man's plight through a forest lookout at the head of Lake Chelan. He messaged the mountaineer would probably die unless he could be airlifted to a hospital quickly.

The party was in Park Creek pass, 23 miles northeast of the head of Lake Chelan, when the man became ill. The 6,200-foot high pass lies between Stehkin at the head of the lake and Seattle City Light's Diablo Dam.

Lt. Cmdr. D. W. DeFreest, the helicopter pilot, said he planned to fly the ill man to Sand Point Naval Air Station at Seattle. He listed Paine Air Force Base near Everett as an alternate goal.

One crewman was in the 'copter with the pilot.

Seattle Times Announces Subscription Raises

SEATTLE (AP) — The Seattle Times announced rate increases Tuesday effective Aug. 1, for all sales of Sunday editions.

New home subscription rates will be \$2.00 a month for daily and Sunday editions, \$1.35 a month for daily editions and 20 cents a copy for Sunday. This makes the combined rate 25 cents a month higher, the daily 10 cents, Newstand sales of daily papers will remain at 5 cents.

Identical rates were announced a day earlier by Seattle's other daily newspaper, the morning Post-Intelligencer. Both cited rising costs as forcing the increase.

The firm is also presently designing the Westminster Presbyterian Church of Eugene and the First Presbyterian Church of Newport.
