Sutherlin To Open Bids On Police Car

Also on the council agenda is a request from the League of Oregon Cities for Sutherlin city officials to attend the organization's convention at Portland in October. An audit report of Young, Walpole and Co. of Roseburg, will be presented to the council. The audit report will cover the municipal books of the past fiscal year.

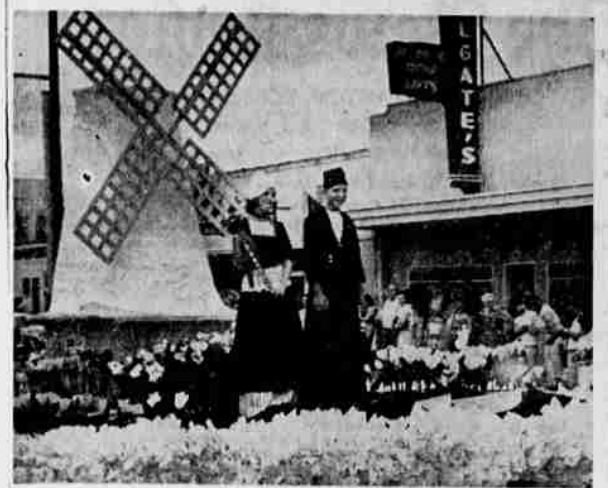

regulations of the city. The council requested information from the State Industrial Accident Commission on insurance coverage for reserve police officers. The information has been received from the commission and will be presented to the council.

The city attorney will give information on delinquent property tax and sewerage loans.
