Methodist Church Gets New Pews

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Graham Claims Crusade Record; To Close Sunday

NEW YORK (AP)—Billy Graham said Thursday his New York crusade had reached more millions than any other religious undertaking in the history of the Christian Church.

The evangelist said nearly two million persons had attended the four months of meetings he has conducted in Madison Square Garden and that additional millions had been reached by Saturday night coast-to-coast radio and television broadcasts.

Dr. Graham winds up his crusade here Sunday night with an outdoor rally in Times Square. After a three-week vacation, he will return for conferences with religious leaders. He said he may conduct some meetings late in September or early in October in surrounding communities in New Jersey, Connecticut, Westchester and Long Island. He will hold a rally Oct. 27 at the Polo Grounds.

He said a news conference that he hoped his crusade would be a "bomb" to open the door to spiritual revival in New York.

In a four-page report on the New York crusade, Graham said it set a number of records.

He listed significant facts that his crusade here:

Was the longest in history of modern day evangelism.

Had the greatest attendance of any evangelistic crusade on record (1,814,400 to date).

Produced a record for him of 53,628 "decisions for Christ."

He said his closing meeting in New York Sunday night was being held in famous Times Square not "just to have a big crowd," but in the hope "it would be a symbol to the whole world of the spiritual renaissance of this country."
