The fourth quarter jinx hit the Roseburg Indians again Friday night as South Eugene took a District 5-A-1 football game 20-0 on Finlay Field.

Leading only 7-0 at the end of the third period, the Axemen broke loose for 13 points in the final 12 minutes of action to take their second league win of the year against no losses. The loss for Roseburg gives it a no-win and one-loss record in league action.

The Indians had a second and five situation on their own 14-yard line just as the time ran out in the third period. On the first play of the last quarter of action Indian quarterback Bob Steele fumbled the ball and an alert Rick Cerkony dropped on the ball for the Axemen.

Two plays later fullback Charles Wilson crossed the goal line from four yards out to give the Axemen their second touchdown of the game. For the second straight time Cerkony booted the ball for the extra point. Over 10 minutes were still to be played in the game.

Pass Scores A Touchdown

The first Axeman score of the game came with about six and one-half minutes left in the first half on a 18-yard pass from quarterback Charlie Warren to end John Polhemus.

After that, Roseburg was stopped when Warren grabbed a Rod Hoenisch pass out of the air on his own 40-yard line.

Both clubs battled to a standoff in the first quarter, with Roseburg doing most of the ball carrying. The Indians managed to rack up three first downs in the opening

period again only two for the Axemen.

In the second quarter Roseburg moved to the Eugene 32-yard line, mainly on two sparkling runs by Hoenisch. With time running out in the half, two passes from Hoenisch to Dennis Batsh and Russ Pinard fell incomplete to cut short the drive.

On the final play of the first half, Batsh grabbed a Warren pass out of the air, but was pinned to the ground before he could break loose for any yardage.

The final touchdown came on a 47-yard run by Munyon late in the game. The extra point was added on another pass from Reynolds to Young.

This was the third straight win of the season for Glendale against no losses and their second Rogue League win.

Two added extra points by Camas Valley spelled the difference Friday afternoon at Camas Valley as the Hornets defeated Triangle Lake 14-12 in a non-league six-man football game.

The game was played in a sea of mud, with the ball being hard to hold. Both teams had several fumbles that might have resulted in other touchdowns.

Byron Baker was the touchdown king for the Hornets as he collected both scores. The first came in the second period on a 52-yard end run. What proved to be the game winning point came on a pass from Mac McClellan to John Wheeler for the extra point.

Triangle Lake had opened the scoring in the first period on a 20-yard pass from Worthington to Gard to put them out in front. A drop kick for the extra point was no good.

Visitors Score Again
For the second time in the game, Triangle Lake went ahead in the scoring with a second period score. Don went over from the two-yard line to cap a scoring drive of 28 yards in seven plays. Again the try for extra point was no good on a line plunge.

The winning touchdown for Camas Valley came with five minutes left in the game on a three-yard plunge by Baker. This second touchdown was set up on two long passes from Baker to Jim Irwin and from Baker to Wheeler. The extra point was added on a pass from McClellan to Irwin.

Back Goes 45 Yards
Taking a handoff from quarterback Bill Dandell in the fourth period, Ken Bowman traveled 45 yards for the second score. This touchdown was set up after a Canyonville fumble deep in Eagle territory. Again the try for extra point was no good on a line smash.

Canyonville threatened to hit pay dirt in the closing seconds of the first half, when they reached the Yoncalla 20-yard line, but a stiff Eagle defense held them for downs.

Ted Bowman had several teeth knocked out in the opening quarter and saw only limited action for the rest of the day to hold the Yoncalla running attack down considerably.

Reedsport Rallies To Down Florence
Behind 6-0 at the end of the first half, the Reedsport Braves broke loose for three touchdowns in the third period to nab a 27-19 win over Florence in a District 2-A-2 football game at Florence Friday.

Halfback Del Reavis figured in all three of the Florence scores. He scored the first period score on a three-yard plunge, scored the second touchdown in the fourth quarter on a eight-yard run and passed to Harold McClellan for 30 yards and the third score. Reavis also scored the only extra point of the game for Florence.

In the third period for Reedsport, Clayton Ladd denied the goal line for the first score on a five-yard run. Jerry Abbott added the second on another five-yard run.

A pass from Bob Celler to Art Smith good for 57 yards gave Reedsport its final third period score. Ladd added two of the extra points and Leland Koepke the third.

A fourth quarter score for Reedsport came on an 88-yard run around end by Koepke. The try for extra point was blocked.
