Former Secretary Wilson Denies He Blocked Funds

DETROIT (AP)—Former Defense Secretary Charles E. Wilson has denied charges he blocked funds for this country's earth satellite program. He says his critic, Dr. Clifford C. Furnas, didn't know all the details of the outer space project.

"Furnas just didn't understand where the ball was" when he was assistant secretary of defense for research and development between November 1955 and last January, Wilson said.

Wilson said the Defense Department was "interested in the project but basically it was not the Defense Department's business."

Rocket Firing Proves Failure At Florida Site

MISSILE TEST CENTER, Cape Canaveral, Fla. (AP)—A rocket believed to be an Army Jupiter lit up the launching area Friday night in an apparent flame-out that failed to lift it off the ground.

Another missile built to launch an earth satellite—the Navy's Vanguard—sat inert on its ramp despite two surges of activity that were either firing preparations or rehearsals.

Information officers at nearby Patrick Air Force Base were as mute as the monster rockets about developments, but if usual procedure rules, firing would be suspended during the weekend.

Diehard rocket fans—and newsmen—still were squinting at the closely guarded launching area from four-mile range Friday night when someone yelled prematurely "There it goes!"

The missile standing in the Jupiter and Redstone rocket firing area glowed brilliantly in the darkness and smoke rose around it. But when the light died out, the missile still hadn't gone anywhere. Veteran observers said it appeared to have misfired.

A flame-out, in which a missile's fuel burns out on the launching site, is not necessarily disastrous to the rocket and sometimes indicates some failure of mechanism or fuel feed.
