Sen. Neuberger Praises Warren As Justice

PORTLAND — The naming of Earl Warren as chief justice of the Supreme Court was President Eisenhower's happiest appointment, Sen. Neuberger (D-Ore.) said this week. "The court's recent decisions on civil liberties and human rights, under Justice Warren's humanitarian guidance, will cause his opinions to rank in stature and meaning with those of the great court members of the past," Neuberger said. The senator told the Men's Club of Congregation Ahavai Sholem that the troubles at Little Rock may indicate a need for a federal police force. Such a force "would be more acceptable to a nation which is not accustomed to the use of troops to enforce civil obedience," said Neuberger.

SALEM — Six of the seven Supreme Court justices will be in Pendleton next Monday and Tuesday for the fall term of its Eastern Oregon session. The only justice who doesn't plan to go is Hall S. Lusk.

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Crosby, Sinatra TV Show Was Gonzaga Benefit

SPOKANE — The president of Gonzaga University said here that the school expects proceeds of about \$250,000 from the television show it produced starring Bing Crosby and Frank Sinatra.

The Very Rev. Edmund W. Morton S. J. said the money will be applied toward the cost of the Crosby Memorial Library which Bing has donated to his Alma Mater.

The \$700,000 library will be officially dedicated here Nov. 3 and Crosby will attend the ceremonies. Crosby, a law student in the Gonzaga class of 1924 who left school for show business before graduation, is now a member of the school's Board of Regents and helped arrange the television production.

The show recently (on CBS for the Ford Motor Co.) carried the credit line, "A Gonzaga University Production". Crosby and Sinatra took minimum fees for their performances. Gonzaga actually had no part in the technical phases of the production and said it merely "packaged and sold" the show as producer.

Communists Play Up Stock Market Plunge

VIENNA — Communist propagandists in Eastern Europe Wednesday played up the recent price crashes in the New York and London markets as forecasting economic depression for the United States and the Western world.

Typical was Volksstimme, newspaper of the Austrian Communist Party, whose top frontpage headline proclaimed: "Crash in Wall Street — Worsening of the American Economic Situation."

Its dispatch said: "Observers in New York say the panic in Wall Street is the result of the succession of failures in U. S. foreign policy, industrial production cutbacks and the complete closing of some factories."

The paper also played up the recent statement of British Laborite Leader Hugh Gaitskill that there is a real prospect of a world slump.

The Soviet news agency Tass and East European satellite radios have been issuing similar reports. In contrast they have been claiming strength for the Soviet economy and touting Russia's recent scientific advances.

Northwest Farm Council Ends Its 1957 Meeting

EPHRATA, Wash. — The Pacific Northwest Farm Council ended its 1957 meeting Tuesday with the election of A. Lars Nelson of St. John, Wash., as president for the coming year. Named to serve with Nelson were Raphael Raymond, president of the Oregon Wheat Growers' League, vice president; and Mrs. Lorraine Mills, Redmond, Wash., secretary-treasurer.

The 60 delegates were told by Earl Hobson, farm price specialist at Washington State College, that he expects an economic readjustment within the next two years which he said will be worse than the 1949 recession but not as bad as the 1929 depression.
