Former Sen. McKellar Dies At Age Of 88 Years

MEMPHIS (AP) — Former Sen. Kenneth Douglas McKellar, 88, top figure in the Roosevelt and Truman administrations, died Friday at the age of 88.
Death came at a nursing home to which he was admitted recently.
McKellar underwent a gastric stomach resection last winter to remove a duodenal ulcer. He had been in frail health since.
A bachelor, McKellar was a power in the Democratic Party during his 36 years in the Senate. His seniority made him dean of the Senate during his final term. For years he was chairman of the Appropriations Committee, which holds the Congressional purse strings.

Bomarc Missile Knocks Down Drone Plane At 100 Miles

WASHINGTON (AP) — The Air Force Thursday reported a Bomarc supersonic long-range interceptor missile had knocked down a drone plane more than 100 miles out over the Atlantic.
The target test was made Wednesday from Patrick Air Force Base, Fla. The Air Force said its powerful new missile reached a height of more than 60,000 feet before making a direct hit on an unmanned B-17 plane.
Bomarc missiles, now in production by the Boeing Co., have an effective range of up to 300 miles, traveling at speeds more than 2 1/2 times that of sound.
