Flu May Be On Second World Journey

CLEVELAND (AP) — Dr. Leroy E. Burney, U.S. surgeon general, said this week that Asian flu may have started its second trip around the world.

Here to attend a meeting of the American Public Health Assn., Dr. Burney said in an interview he had learned officially that Japan had been hit by a second wave of the disease, with 300,000 new cases.

"It is a possibility that the United States will be hit a second time," he said.

He added that he had received an unofficial report that China was hit by a second wave of the flu, but that reports indicated the flu again is the mild type in both countries.

Dr. Burney pointed out that the first wave of flu in the United States has not ended and that so far some 700 out of the 3,000 counties in the country have reported epidemics.

FLU SWEEPING JAPAN

TOKYO (AP) — A second wave of Asian influenza is sweeping Japan and four deaths were reported in Tokyo Saturday.

The United States is the only country in the world that has developed an effective vaccination program against the disease, he said.

"Now we have 40 million units of vaccine," he added.

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
