## Enraged Bull Kills Owner

COLTON, Wash. (AP)—A mad bull who reportedly goes into a rage at the sight of machinery, attacked and killed a 45-year-old man on his Whitman County farm near here Wednesday.

Glen Simpson, a dairy and grain farmer, was found unconscious by his wife beneath a small wheel tractor he had been using to clean out his barn.

The bull was standing nearby, Simpson's death was attributed to severe head and chest injuries inflicted by the animal.

Mrs. Simpson was able to get the bull into a pen and then called for help. Her husband died as he was being taken by ambulance to a Pullman hospital.

The bull, who has no horns, was known on the farm as a machine eater. It appeared Simpson was near the tractor and then sought protection beneath it.

Besides his wife, Simpson is survived by two sons and a daughter.

## Eugene To Get Office For Aging

EUGENE (AP)—The state office of the governor's Council for Services to the Aging will be established in Eugene.

This was decided Wednesday when the council's executive committee held its first meeting on the Lewis and Clark College campus in Portland.

The state office will be located in the First Congregational Church in Eugene. Wesley G. Nicholson, pastor, is chairman of the council.

Eugene City Councilwoman Catherine Lauris, a member of the council and its executive committee, said several candidates for the position of executive secretary were interviewed Wednesday. A decision will not be reached until the full 45-member council meets Jan. 29 in Salem, he said.

The council's job is to gather facts and make recommendations to the 1959 Legislature on problems of the aging.
