

Road Construction Holding Own, But May Lag By 1960

WASHINGTON — Federal highway Administrator Bertram D. Tallamy reported Wednesday construction contracts have been advertised on 3,175 miles of the nation's 41,000-mile superhighway system since mid-1956.

Total Cost Reported

The total cost of these was \$1,729,000,000, with \$1,494,000,000 of it supplied by the federal government which pays a 90 per cent share.

A Bureau of Public Roads spokesman said 1,255 miles of the interstate roads — part of them started before the new program became effective — were completed in the 18-month period at a cost of 270 millions.

Norwegian Ship Breaks In Two

GENOA, Italy — The Norwegian tanker Seirstad broke in two in a racing Mediterranean storm Wednesday and at least 28 crew members were rescued.

The Dutch freighter Bintang messaged she had rescued the 28. The Captain, A. C. W. Latour, told his home office in Amsterdam 10 crewmen were missing from the 9,974-ton Norwegian ship and a search was continuing.

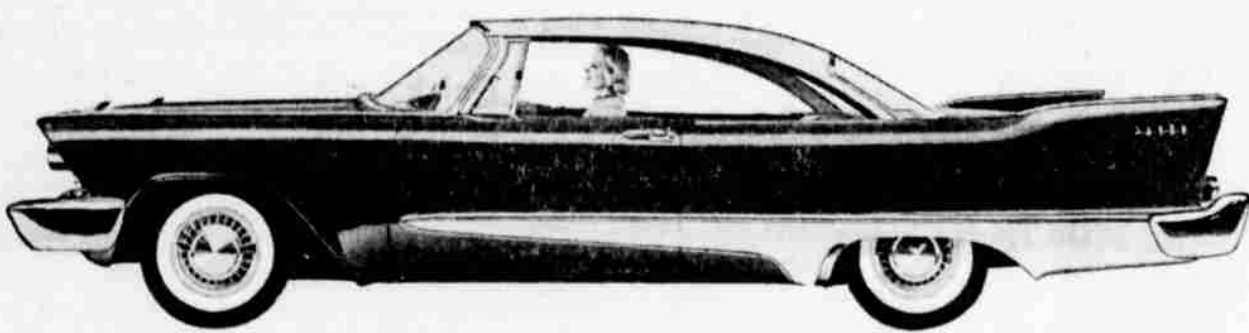
