

Baylor Scores 23; Point Edge Narrow

Elin Baylor of Seattle came mighty close to losing his No. 1 spot among the nation's major college individual basketball scorers Thursday night when he tallied a sub par 23 points against Montana State.

Baylor's average skidded to 33.9 on 677 points in 20 games as Seattle edged Montana State 78-77, Cincinnati's Oscar Robertson, idle Thursday night, trails by only three-tenths of a point.

Leo Byrd of Marshall also saw his average drop to an even 26 points as he scored a mere 15 points as Murray State defeated the West Virginia Club 98-92.

Notre Dame's Tom Hawkins only other member of the top ten in action, held his own with 25 points in the Irish's 93-77 conquest of New York University.

Eddie Arcaro Boots Home 4,000th Winner

ARCADIA, Calif. — Another chapter is added Friday to the brilliant racing career of Eddie Arcaro.

He has become a member of the exclusive "4,000 club" — The third man in the history of horse racing to ride 4,000 or more winners.

The fabled 4,000, which had eluded the 42-year-old stakes king of American racing since the third race at Santa Anita Park last Tuesday, came in the eighth and final race Thursday.

It was aboard a 5-year-old brown gelding named Bar, no more nor less distinguished than the first horse Eddie rode to victory in a long distance afternoon at Tijuana's famed Caliente track in Mexico.

Riding Said Dangerous
That one's name was Eagle Bird and he started Arcaro on the road to true greatness in one of the most grueling, dangerous and exciting tests of an athlete in sports.

Arcaro received a fine ovation from the 21,500 fans on hand Thursday. But, for a man with some 27 years of riding behind him, Eddie was the least excited.

"Actually, it was just another day of racing for me but I'm glad to have reached the 4,000 mark and to get it over with," he said.

Two Others Win 4,000
Only two other jockeys in the world have ridden 4,000 winners. They are the still active Johnny (Grandpa) Longden, with 5,092, and the now retired Sir Gordon Richards of England, with 4,870.

Arcaro has won some 443 stakes whose earnings amount to more than \$23,000,000.

The record shows victories in five Kentucky Derbies, six in the Preakness and six in the Belmont Stakes, which includes triumphs aboard two triple crown winners, Whirlaway in 1941 and Citation in 1948.

Arcaro left last night for Florida to ride the Hasty House Farm's Maban in the \$100,000 Widener Handicap at Hialeah Saturday. He had been signed to ride Bold Ruler but the ruler was declared out of the race Thursday after suffering a slight injury.

Mick Ready To Ink \$75,000 Contract

ST. PETERSBURG, Fla. — Outfielder Mickey Mantle and the New York Yankees appear close to agreement on a salary for the 1958 baseball season. The price is estimated at \$75,000.

An announcement is expected early next week from Lee MacPhail, assistant to Yankees General Manager George Weiss. If Mantle signs for \$75,000, he will receive more money than any other player in Yankee history except Joe DeMaggio (\$100,000) and the late Babe Ruth (\$80,000).

Mantle's 1957 salary was estimated at \$60,000.

MacPhail said, "The entire thing should be cleared up in a few days."

Mantle, 26, hit 34 home runs and drove in 94 runs last year. A leg injury sidelined him most of September but he wound up with a .365 batting average.

Mantle has been in Florida playing golf. MacPhail, asked when he expected to confer with him again, said, "We have no definite appointment. . . . He comes to the park every day and so do I."
