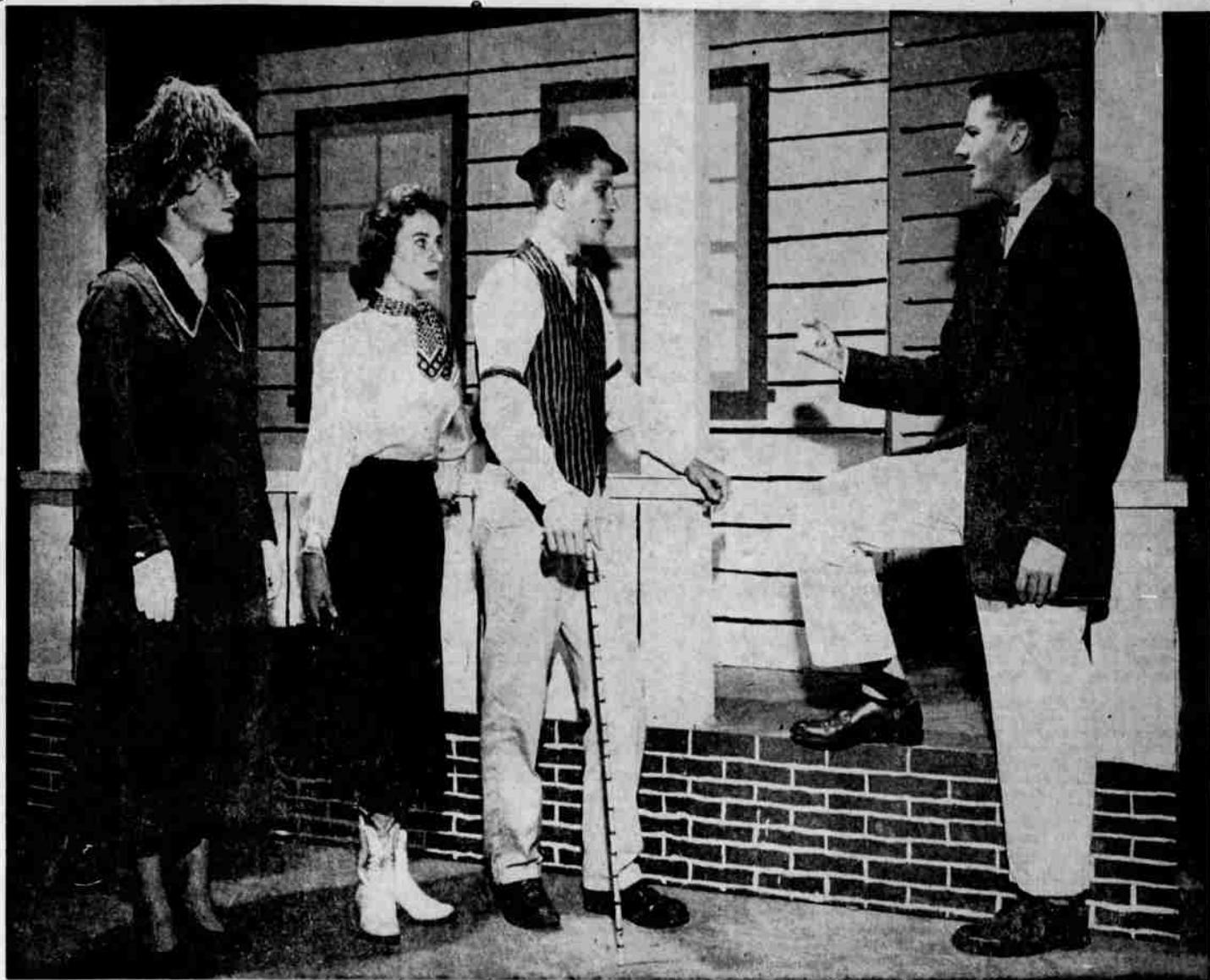

Buffalo Bill's manager, Charlie Davenport, is played by Bob Scott. The girls are Dolly Tate (Marilyn Todd), and Winnie Tate (Alice Hamilton). At center right are Pawnee Bill (Phil Richeson) and Sylvia Potter-Porter, (Lorna Cummins) who offer a toast to Buffalo Bill (Jerry Halladay).

IN THE LOWER LEFT picture, Judie Vineyard (double-casted as Dolly Tate) shakes a menacing finger at Tommy Keeler, (Tommy Heinz) (she's real put-out 'cause he married her daughter). Dave Forrest plays Mac, the property man of the Wild West Show, and Bob Johnson plays Chief Sitting Bull. In the lower right picture are Annie Oakley (double-casted by Shirleen Cottrell) and her sisters, Nellie (Donna Frisk); Minnie (Jerry Healy); Jessie, (Mary Clapperton), and her young brother, Little Jake, (Steve Duncan).



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
