Salvation Army, Library Speakers On Rotary Fare

The Salvation Army and National Library Week shared the spotlight at the weekly Roseburg Rotary Club meeting Thursday noon at the Hotel Umpqua.

Members of a cadet team, now in officers training school at San Francisco, Calif., were guests of honor at the meeting. The team is now taking field training, conducting meetings in Oregon communities. The last of the meetings is being held tonight at the Salvation Army building on NE Winchester Street at 7:30. It is public.

One of the members of the team at the Rotary meeting, Dr. Lyle Alloway, told of the events leading to his decision to become part of the Army. He is a physician from Nampa, Idaho. Other members introduced were Kenneth Angel of Stockton, Calif., Jack Elledge of Caldwell, Bill Luttrell of Greeley, Colo., and William Muleh of Bakersfield, Calif.

'Play' Bottles

In the line of entertainment, the team played a song by blowing into wine bottles "with a shady past."

Also speaking for the Army were Lt. Raymond A. Dexter, brigade officer in charge of the team, and Maj. Len Adams, youth director for Oregon and Southern Idaho. Lt. Bruce Harvey of the local Salvation Army station introduced the men.

Two speakers issued a call for greater use of libraries in connection with National Library Week. Sandra Densmore of Roseburg High urged any people of the community to visit the Roseburg High Library. She said 100 people had attended the open house at the school Wednesday.

The second speaker was Miss Carol Trimble, Douglas County librarian. She insisted that the country is facing its greatest challenge to democracy now and it cannot be faced adequately "without a broad background of knowledge."

Many Didn't Read

Miss Trimble said a recent Gallup poll had shown in the last year that 61 per cent of adults in the country had not read a book.

Bringing it down to the local level, she pointed out that last year, 305,000 books were circulated and 18,000 county readers hold library cards. This more than doubles the figures of 1953-54, she said, but it still leaves far more people than 61 per cent of the population who probably didn't read a book during the year.

Miss Trimble also invited anyone to see the facilities of the county library during National Library Week.
