

Nickel Smelting Plant Produced 18 Million Pounds

The nickel smelting plant at Riddle, operated by the Hanna Nickel Smelting Co., produced more than 18 million pounds of contained nickel in 1957, its first full year of capacity operation.

The information was revealed in the M. A. Hanna Co.'s annual report to stockholders.

The report says over a million tons of ore were produced at the mine on Nickel Mountain and transported over the two-mile aerial tramway to the plant 2,300 feet below.

The report indicates that research programs of the company had aided in increasing the amount of nickel recovered from the ore going into the plant. It also says that research will be continued.

The M. A. Hanna Co. reported a consolidated net profit of \$21,365,079 from all operations during the year. It was the highest in history.
