

### Employee Can't Be Fired For Opposing Merger

SAN FRANCISCO — An employee cannot be fired for opposing a merger favored by his employer, a National Labor Relations Board examiner said here.

Spencer, who conducted a hearing at Eugene last November, said Hedlund was one of a number of Snellstrom employees who owned stock in Viking Plywood and Lumber, a Washington corporation. Hedlund had owned half of the Snellstrom Co. since 1951. A Snellstrom proposal for merger of the firms led to the employees forming rival committees, seeking proxies and against merger. Spencer said the merger proposal was defeated in 1956, but company resentment against Hedlund's active part in the matter led to his firing, Spencer said.
