

President Says He Deplores Use Of Federal Troops

WASHINGTON — President Eisenhower said Wednesday he deplores the use of federal troops to carry out federal court orders in civil rights cases.

But the President told his news conference the fundamental rights of all Americans would be endangered by any successful defiance of a court order.

Eisenhower made these comments in response to questions concerning his attitude toward recent school integration developments in Virginia and a statement by Gov. Leroy Collins of Florida in a magazine article that Collins supports continued segregation in that state.

Eisenhower was asked if he intends to follow "the Little Rock pattern" if he encounters further defiance of court orders in school and other integration matters. The reporter was referring to his action in sending troops into Little Rock, Ark., to enforce a federal court order for integration in Central High School there.

Would Enforce Order
Eisenhower asked the reporter what was meant by the Little Rock pattern. When the reply was the use of troops to enforce a court order, the President said that's the point.

Eisenhower said he didn't send troops because of some statement made by a governor. He said there had been mob interference in the execution of a court order and then the statement by Gov. Orval Faubus that he would not intervene to uphold the federal court's order.
