

### Bangkok Area Cholera Deaths Up Further

BANGKOK, Thailand (AP) — Twenty more cholera deaths were reported Monday in Bangkok and surrounding areas, bringing to 367 the number who have died in Thailand's epidemic. Since the epidemic began last month 3,389 cases have been reported in Bangkok and 3,861 in the entire country. The epidemic now has spread to South Viet Nam and Cambodia.

### DIVORCE PLANNED

### Five-Year Co-Op On Ferrochrome Program Sought

WASHINGTON (AP) — Sen. Wayne Morse (D-Ore.) has asked the Senate Interior Committee to give serious consideration to a proposal by Pacific Northwest chrome miners for a five-year ferrochrome cooperative program.

He told the committee, now studying a long-range minerals program, the suggestion was made by chrome miners in Oregon and Washington and Hollis M. Dole, director of Oregon's Department of Geology and Mineral Industries. Under the proposal, Morse said, the government would agree to buy a certain tonnage of ferrochrome each year for five years. The ferrochrome would come from newly mined chrome ores at current market prices and be handled similar to other stockpile materials.

The program also would provide loans by the government to permit establishment of facilities for producing ferrochrome from domestic ores by a cooperative or-

ganization of chrome miners.

In urging consideration of the proposal, Morse told the committee he has been advised by chrome miners in Oregon and California that present legislative proposals before the committee offer encouragement but little real practical benefit to the small Oregon chrome miner.

### Six In Hospital After Greyhound Bus Plunge

MARIETTA, Ga. (AP) — A Greyhound bus spun out of control in a rainstorm, plunged down an embankment and tipped over on its side Saturday.

Six persons remained hospitalized today but were reported in good condition. Fourteen others were treated at the hospital and dismissed.

The accident occurred on busy four-lane U.S. 41 about five miles south of Marietta.

Police quoted driver Floyd A. Jones, 46, as saying the bus was going down a hill in blinding rain when he applied the brakes and the right front wheel locked. The bus spun around, went down a 25-foot embankment and toppled over about 35 feet from the highway.

Officers said the accident was unavoidable and that no charges will be made.
