Plenty Of Variety Slated Over State For Fourth Holidays

Oregon will have plenty of variety in Fourth of July entertainment this year.

Seven rodeos, a state championship track meet, several pageants and many festivals and fireworks displays are on the schedule compiled by the state Highway Department for the weekend of July 4-6. Rodeos scheduled are at Baker, July 3-4; St. Paul, July 3-5; Molalla, July 3-6; Paulina, July 4-5; Yoncalla, July 4-5; Enterprise, July 4-5, and Klamath Falls, July 4-6.

The state AAU track meet will be held in Eugene July 4, featuring a special mile run.

Bend's Water Pageant, featuring colorful floats on the Deschutes River, will be July 4-5. The Albany-Timber Carnival, with championship events in logging contests, is July 2-4.

Other celebrations for the week-end include: Willamette River Days at Salem, July 4; Happy Days Celebration at Hillsboro, July 4; Beachcombers' Days Pageant at Waldport, July 4; Warrenton Mooring Basin Dedication, July 4, and the Friendship Jamboree at Vernonia, July 4-5.

Fireworks displays will be held in connection with many of these events and separately on July 4 at Manzanita, Seaside, Waldport, Ashland and Taft.

Graham Hopeful Of New Crusade In Sacramento

SACRAMENTO, Calif. (AP) — Billy Graham, opening his eight-day crusade of evangelism here, says his visit can be the beginning of a spiritual awakening in Sacramento that will last a generation.

The crusade opened at the state fairgrounds Sunday night before a crowd of 18,450, about two-thirds sitting on the grass. About 550 came forward for "decisions for Christ."

Gov. Harold J. Powers hailed Graham as "America's outstanding ambassador of good will," and said his visit can bring lasting spiritual, moral and social benefits to California.

Graham, preaching on "what's wrong with the world," warned that there is a trend in this country toward a "beatnik" or "beat generation" attitude. "An attitude that says I'm going to get mine and enjoy it today and not worry about tomorrow."

"We have a world of unbalanced people trying to solve the problems of the world and they can't do it. They're people who have concentrated on feeding the mind and have neglected the neglected soul," Graham said.

He said if people turn from their sins God will give them the power to be victorious over them.

Green Thumb's Jealous Rival Poisons Plant

ORPINGTON, England (AP) — Col. John Southern claimed Monday a jealous rival in the green thumb field has poisoned his prize garden.

The culprit, so far uncaught, sprinkled the colonel's lawn, flowers and trees with sodium chlorate, a weed-killer. The garden, which had won first prize in a competition for best in the district, is now a mess of dead and dying vegetation.

"Someone was jealous of my wonderful garden," said the colonel. "I'll catch the rogue if it costs every penny I have."

He called in police and offered a 20-pound (\$50) reward for information leading to the arrest of the garden-slayer.
