Sunspots Probably Grow From Small Pores, Says Researcher

MADISON, Wis. — Sunspots, those mole-like blemishes on the face of the sun, probably grow from small pores, Princeton University research indicated today.

The solar radiation, hitting the earth, upsets the normal layers of the atmosphere, making them absorb radio waves instead of bouncing them back to earth. Radio transmitters get their long range by bouncing radio waves off these layers in the sky, and so reach far beyond the horizon with the straight-traveling waves.

The small pores, scattered at random over the sun's boiling surface, apparently grow larger until they become full-grown sunspots. These dark areas on the sun give off only 30 per cent as much light as the brighter parts of the sun.

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Western, Soviet Scientists Meet

GENEVA (AP) — Western and Soviet bloc scientists sat down to discuss Tuesday for technical talks on how to police a possible ban on atomic tests.

Eight nations — four from the West and four from the East — were represented in the talks at U.S. European headquarters here.

The participants are the United States, the Soviet Union, England, France, Canada, Romania, Czechoslovakia and Poland.

Dr. James B. Fisk, head of the U.S. delegation, said the negotiators "embark, with every hope, on what can well be an historic mission — to lay the essential technical basis for the important decisions which lie ahead."

Yevgeni K. Fedorov, chief of the Soviet delegation, endorsed Fisk's statements limiting the talks to technical phases of atomic test control.

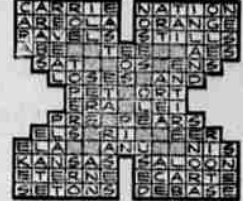
