France To Explode First A-Bomb Soon, Report Says

LONDON (AP)—France is to explode her first atom bomb in the next two weeks or so, the London Daily Mail reported today.

The test weapon will be a "small content" bomb of about 20 pounds of plutonium and will be set off in the Sahara, the newspaper said.

The Mail added: "The French are said to be still worried as to whether their bomb is fully ready. They fear a failure, yet cannot ask directly for American help."

More American Tourists Arrive In Soviet Union

LONDON (AP)—Moscow Radio Wednesday reported increasing numbers of American tourists are arriving in the Soviet Union by car.

The influx also has been "particularly great" from Britain, Sweden, France and Czechoslovakia, the broadcast said.

Announcing a new auto route for foreign tourists from Julivipula on the Finnish border, via Leninograd, Novgorod and Kalinin to Moscow, the radio said 2,300 visitors are expected to take this road this summer.

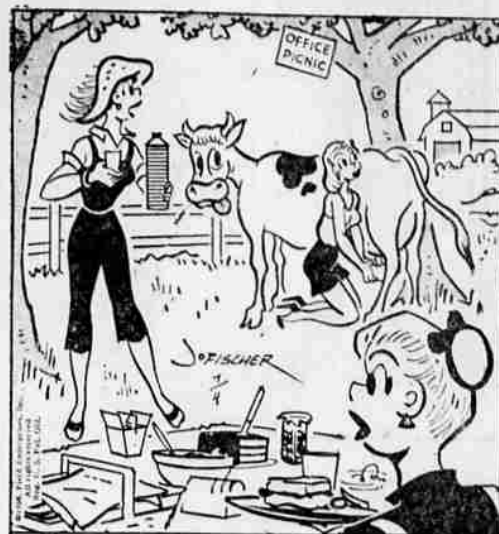
