He received 1,764 votes to 203 for Cyril A. Krenser, a printer of Lakewood, Ohio. Other officers were elected without opposition. Wisely will be installed for a one-year term as leader of the 1,250,000-member fraternal order Thursday. He will succeed H. L.

Blackledge, a lawyer of Kearney, Neb. A message of greeting from President Eisenhower said the Elks "provide splendid leadership in charity and civic affairs across the land."

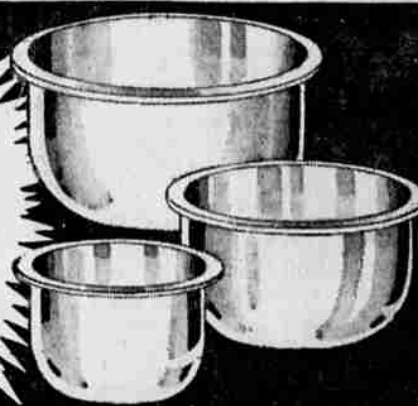
