Unidentified Flying Objects Are Real, Says Psychologist

ALAMOGORDO, N.M. (AP) — Dr. Carl Jung, Swiss psychologist, says in a report that Unidentified Flying Objects are real and "show signs of intelligent guidance by quasihuman pilots."
"I can only say for certain these things are not a mere rumor."

something has been seen," Jung said in the report. "A purely psychological explanation is ruled out."
Jung, who started his research on UFOs in 1944, released his report through the UFO filter center of the Aerial Phenomena Research Organization here. It was released by L. J. Lorenzen of Holloman Air Force Base.

This phenomena should be confirmed, Jung would prove the existence of an intelligent interplanetary relationship. What such a fact might mean for humanity cannot be predicted.
"But it would put us without doubt in the extremely precarious position of primitive communities in conflict with the superior culture of the whites."

Denied
The Air Force has said investigation of flying saucers reported over the past 10 years has produced no evidence that such things exist.

It has contended that not a shred of evidence has turned up to show the existence of a flying saucer or interplanetary space ship or that the objects sighted indicate developments beyond the range of current scientific knowledge or pose a threat to the nation's security.

The Air Force said last November investigations of 5,700 reported sightings showed the mysterious objects were balloons, aircraft, astronomical phenomena, birds, fireworks or hoaxes among other things.

Johns-Manville Delays Opening Of Big Plant

NEW YORK (AP) — Johns-Manville Corp. delayed the opening of a \$12½ million dollar insulation board plant at Chiloquin, Ore., because of a lack of a market for acoustical board.
W. H. Graham, plant manager in Oregon, said "There just hasn't been enough demand for the insulation board to warrant the plant's opening."
Graham said the plant might open later in the summer, but no date was set. At full production the plant is expected to employ 250 persons.

Manager Of Strife-Torn County PUD Resigns

EPHRATA, Wash. (AP) — Glenn Smothers resigned Monday as manager of the strife-torn Grant County Public Utility District.
The three PUD commissioners agreed unanimously to accept Smothers' resignation at a hurriedly called special meeting Monday morning.

The action followed the Friday firing of State Sen. Nat Washington, who has been serving as PUD attorney. Washington had brought charges of improper conduct of PUD affairs against Smothers. At the same meeting, the commissioners voted to retain Smothers as manager, tabling his resignation offer by a vote of 2-1.

Rolin Bowles Named To State Game Commission

SALEM (AP) — Rolin E. Bowles, Portland attorney and past president of the state Water Resources Board, was appointed to the state Game Commission Monday by Gov. Robert D. Holmes.

Appointed for a four-year term, Bowles succeeds Don M. Mitchell, Taft, on the five-man commission. Gov. Holmes appointed Bowles last year to the state Water Resources Board, but the Senate refused to confirm the appointment. The confirmation was blocked by commercial fishing and irrigation interests who feared that Bowles would oppose them.

A Game Commission appointment, however, doesn't require Senate confirmation.

Bowles was born in Bellingham, Wash., 50 years ago, and is a graduate of Northwestern College of Law.
He was state president of the Izak Walton League in 1956, served as its legislative chairman last year, and was active in developing Oregon's new Water Resources Board legislation.

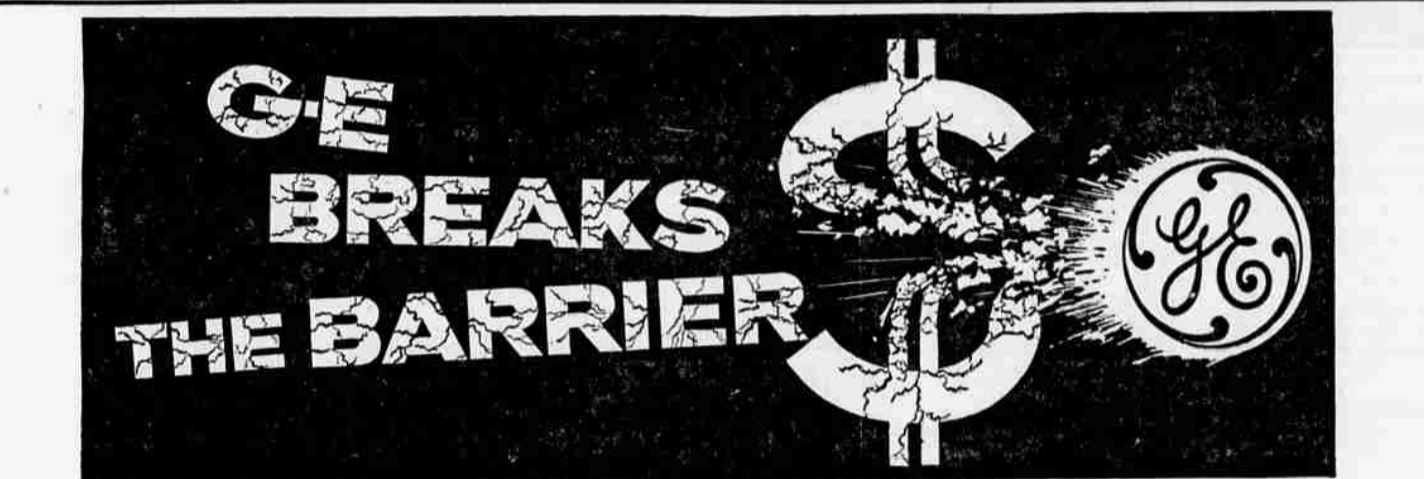
Delegates Of NW Recorded On Vote

WASHINGTON (AP) — How Oregon, Washington and Idaho members of Congress were recorded on recent Senate roll calls.

On Johnson (D-Tex) amendment adopted 63-27, eliminating from reciprocal trade bill a provision that would have curbed the president's tariff making authority: For — Church (D), Jackson (D), Morse (D), Neuberger (D); against — Dworshak (R), Magnuson (D).

On passage, 72-16, of bill extending reciprocal trade act for three years: For — Church, Jackson, Magnuson, Morse, Neuberger; against — Dworshak.
On adoption, 62-25, of Monroney (D-Okl) resolution calling for a study of a proposed new international loan agency to make long term, low interest loans repayable in currencies of participating nations: For — Church, Jackson, Magnuson, Morse, Neuberger; against — Dworshak.
On adoption, 67-9, of Young (R-ND) amendment adding four year extension of wool act to the farm bill: For — Church, Dworshak, Jackson, Magnuson, Morse, Neuberger.
