

Another Meet Slated In Construction Tieup

PORTLAND (AP) — Another negotiating meeting will be held here Thursday in a renewed attempt to settle a 28-day-old labor dispute which has halted 400 million dollars worth of heavy construction in Oregon and Southwest Washington.

Federal Mediator Leroy Smith arranged the new session Tuesday. It will bring together representatives of the Associated General Contractors and the Hoisting and Portable Engineers Union.

Gov. Robert D. Holmes and Mayor Terry Schunk of Portland met with the contractors Tuesday to review issues of the dispute. Upstate union members voted Monday and Tuesday nights on the latest contractor offer, which was rejected by Portland members. There was no immediate report from the union on the upstate vote results.

WATER SKIERS WARNED

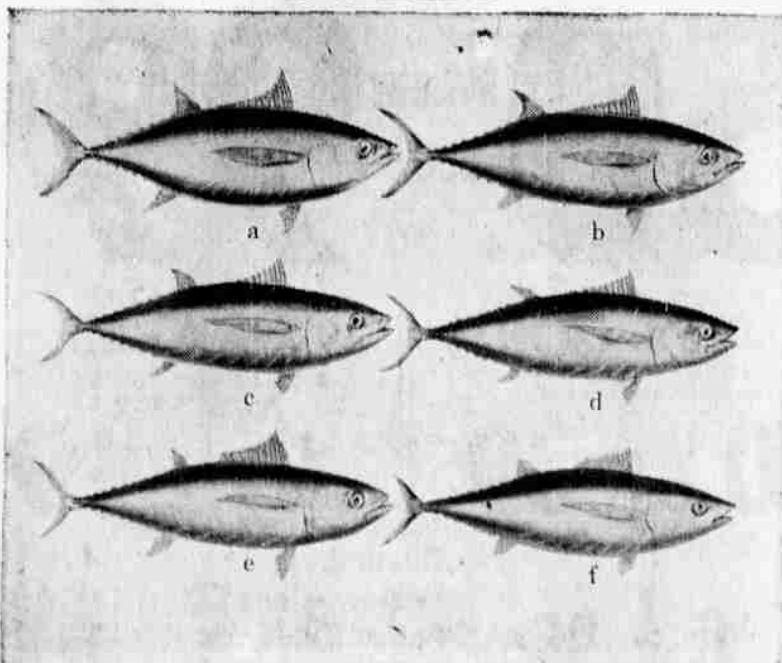
PORTLAND (AP) — Water skiers are not only placing their own lives in danger but are scaring Columbia and Willamette River barge skippers with their antics. Leonard W. Thompson, president of Western Transportation Co., urged water skiers to stay out of the way of moving towboats and barges.

Thompson said that last week a father dumped his 6-year-old son in front of a barge and "we almost ran the boy down."

Boost In Retail Prices Believed Some Time Away

NEW YORK (AP) — Price hikes in aluminum and steel set the stage for a new round of inflation last week as the tempo of the nation's business quickened.

The steel price boost will heighten the cost of making thousands of consumer items ranging from step-on garbage cans to refrigerators and cars. But competition being what it is, you may not see any general rise in retail prices for a while.

Industry people say the 3 per cent increase in mill prices of sheet and strip steel will add about \$8 to the cost of producing an automobile and a few pennies to the cost of making a stove or washing machine.

The aluminum increase (sevenths of a cent a pound) partially restores a two-cent cut made by producers in April.

The week brought over inflationary signals.

The Post Office upped its mailing rates. Those pretty new four-cent stamps are expected to add two dollars a year to the average family's outlay for postage.

The U.S. House of Representatives shouted its approval of a bill to boost social security benefits 7 per cent. If, as seems probable, the bill becomes law, fatter social security checks will mean higher payroll taxes.

Bigger Deficit Looms

Prospects of increased red ink financing by Uncle Sam also fanned inflationary fires.

Briefly over the business scene:

Department store sales last week showed a 3 per cent gain over 1957.

The 1959 Buick cars will go on sale Sept. 19, earliest for Buick since World War II.

Farm product prices declined four-tenths of one per cent between mid-June and mid-July.

2 Persons Held For Forest Fire

EVERETT (AP) — An Arlington logger and a youthful employee were held here Tuesday while officials investigated accusations the pair had been responsible for the costly Cultus Mountain forest fire.

The Arlington man, a 37-year-old gyppo logger, and his 17-year-old helper were arrested by Darwin Hughes, Snohomish County sheriff's deputy.

Hughes said the younger logger admitted the pair operated in the South Skagit County fire area past the noon deadline July 23, left within 20 minutes and failed to maintain a fire watch, all in violation of state regulations.

Hughes said the fire appears to have started from embers caused by a chain saw backfire at the pair's operation. The blaze roared out of control several days and destroyed some 1,800 acres of slash and timber.

State Department of Natural Resources officials estimated it cost \$100,000 to fight the fire and timber losses have not been determined.

The youth was held in the juvenile detention home and the man in the county jail.

ADMIRAL DIES

LONG BEACH, Calif. (AP) — Rear Adm. Joseph R. DeFrees, 82, died early Wednesday at his home.

His wife Bernice told police he had been under treatment for a heart condition for three or four years.

DeFrees was successively chief of staff of the U. S. Scouting Force commander of the submarine force of the U. S. Fleet and commandant of the 11th Naval Dist. before his retirement in 1945.
