

Rotary Governor Tells Achievements Of Organization

Rotary Clubs in 116 countries and geographical regions throughout the world are united in an endeavor to promote international understanding, good will and peace.

This was the report by Leslie A. White of Albany, governor of District 511 of Rotary International. He was the featured speaker at the weekly meeting of the Roseburg Rotary Club in the Umpqua Hotel. The address followed a conference with local Rotary officers and committee chairmen.

White cited additional activities of the more than 9,800 Rotary Clubs in the world to which the organization has been devoted. Among them were \$2,600,000 in student fellowships in the last 11 years. In Roseburg, he cited the work of the local club in building a pavilion at Stewart Park, sponsoring a student from Italy for attendance at Roseburg High School and provision of a college scholarship each year.

"With fellowship and service to others as its keynote, Rotary provides a common ground for 462,500 business and professional executives throughout the world, regardless of differing nationalities or languages or political and religious beliefs," White said.

"In addition to promotion of international understanding," White concluded, "special emphasis is being placed by Rotary clubs on community betterment, youth welfare and vocational service projects."

Tanker Collision Toll Rises To 16

NEWPORT, R.I. (AP) — The death toll in Thursday's collision of two tankers in Newport Harbor rose to 16 Friday with the death of Samuel Williams of Port Arthur Tex., at Newport hospital.

Fifteen were killed in the fog-shrouded crash and 25 injured, several critically. One man is listed as missing.

All of the dead were members of the crew of the Gulfport, a 10,340-ton vessel which was outbound and empty.

Among others killed were Capt. Monteville Eden, and his second officer, Raymond C. Day, both of Port Arthur.

The second tanker involved was the S. E. Graham, a 230-foot motor ship inbound with over half a million gallons of gasoline in her tanks.

Today she was still burning furiously and Coast Guard officers predicted the fire would rage for at least five days unless the ship could be torpedoed.

The ships struck in a zero visibility fog. There was an immediate explosion. Many of the dead men were trapped below decks.

Lifeboats that could be launched were lost in the fog and useless. Crewmen had to jump 20 and 30 feet into the blazing fuel on the water.

The Coast Guard buoy tender Laurel, working nearby, showed up within minutes to pull many crewmen from the sea.

Novelist, Playwright J. P. McEvoy Passes

NEW CITY, N.Y. (AP) — J.P. McEvoy, 64, novelist, playwright and poet, died Friday at his home.

McEvoy, who had been ill for several months, died of a stroke. With him at his bedside were his wife and four children.

McEvoy had been a roving editor for Reader's Digest magazine for 20 years.

He wrote at least 10 Broadway plays and reviews, beginning with "The Pottery" in 1923 and ending in 1939 with "Stars in Your Eyes" starring Ethel Merman and Jimmy Durante.

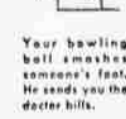
