New Principal At Glide High

Trostel Werth of Gresham has taken over duties as principal of Glide High School. He replaces Ray L. Talbert who is the new principal at Douglas High School. For the past five years Werth has taught mathematics at Gresham Union High School where he was also a counselor and testing officer. Werth has moved to the Glide area with his wife and two daughters.

The new Glide principal received his Bachelor's degree in engineering from Oregon State College. He has also worked as an electrical engineer at Boeing Aircraft Co. in Seattle and for the U.S. Army Engineering Corps.

Werth was a member of the Holiday Park Church board of trustees at Portland, Oregon Council of Churches and the Oregon Youth Planning Commission.

All Elkton Dist. Teachers Back

All teachers in the Elkton School District will be returning to the classrooms when school opens there Sept. 3. This is the first time in many years there has not been a vacancy to fill in the teaching staff, Supt. Leo Crisman reports.

An estimated 75 students are expected to enroll in Elkton High School and 190 in the grade school. First graders are estimated to number at least 26, Mrs. Wade Henderer, News-Review correspondent, reports.

During the summer months improvements to the school facilities have been completed. The high school grounds have been partially landscaped and the rest of the work will be completed next year. A new play shed floor at the grade school has been black topped as well as the area around the swings and merry-go-round.

Other Improvements
Most of the exterior of the grade school has been painted and the roof between the play shed and school building has been extended the full width of the building.

Seven teachers will welcome students back to Elkton High School in September. Crisman, besides serving as superintendent, will also be principal and teach geometry. Carl Grimstad, who has been with the district 13 years, will teach social studies, basketball and baseball.

Girls physical education instructor will be Dorothy M. Halfner. She will also teach commercial subjects. Other instructors will be Bob Pitts, English and librarian; Dick Salomon, football coach, boys physical education, mechanical drawing and shop; Emilie M. France, home economics and science, and William C. Hickerson, music and band.
