In reporting on their journey, Mrs. Anderson said the native people, the hunting and the climate, which was never over 80 degrees, were interesting. They killed buffalo, antelope and monkeys, but brought back only one hunting trophy; the horns and hooves from the smallest variety of antelope. They spent a number of days at various mission stations and were guided in their visit by the Rev. J. J. Davis of Glendale, who returned to the Congo to set up an independent mission station after he and his wife were retired from service by the Methodist Mission Board, following their 30 years as missionaries there. The Andersons attended graduation exercises in a native school, and visited school classes. They also were present at church services held in a leper colony.

## Big Jet To Fly Non-Stop To New York And Return

SPOKANE (AP) — A big B52 jet bomber will fly nonstop to New York City and back Friday to commemorate the 29th anniversary of a similar trip by pioneer Spokane pilot Nick Mamer. Mamer and Art Walker flew the 6,000-mile flight in 1929 in a Buhl cabin plane powered by a 300-horsepower engine and named "Spokane Sun God." The trip via Portland and California took five days and five nights. It was the first transcontinental flight of a plane refueled in the air. The B52 from Fairchild Air Force Base here expects to make the roundtrip to New York in a little over eight hours. Mamer was killed in a commercial plane crash in 1938.
