The sonic booms shook up the towns and damaged a plater and a glass was estimated at \$100. The identity of the planes was not determined.

**GOP Convinced
Adams Will Go**

WASHINGTON — Republican campaigners appear convinced that Sherman Adams will bow out of his White House job within a few days.

Their confidence that President Eisenhower's chief assistant will quit is such that the chairmen of the Senate and HOUSE GOP campaign committees have abandoned plans to issue a joint statement demanding Adams' ouster.

Instead, Sen. Andrew F. Schoepel (R-Kan) and Rep. Richard M. Simpson (R-Pa) are understood to have agreed to sit tight and await developments.

Adams has been a center of political controversy since a House investigating subcommittee disclosed he accepted costly favors
