

Beck Used Union's Money In A 'Peculiar Way' And Became Rich, Says Defense

TACOMA, Wash. (AP)—Dave Beck's defense in his income tax evasion trial will be that he took non-taxable union funds "in a rather peculiar way" and became rich, his lawyers disclosed Monday.

William Dwyer, of Beck's team of defense attorneys, said in an opening statement to a federal court jury that the ex-boss of the Teamsters Union got into trouble through "sloppy" handling of union money.

"But he did no wrong where his taxes were concerned," Dwyer said.

Beck's long-awaited trial opened Monday in U.S. District Court and a jury of eight men and four women was seated with unexpected speed.

Charged With Fraud
The one-time Seattle laundry truck driver, who rose to one of the nation's most powerful labor posts, is charged with defrauding the government out of \$240,000 in income taxes for the years 1930-33.

Dwyer told the jury that when Beck takes the stand he will show he took \$380,000 in Teamsters funds over a period of years, invested the money and eventually repaid it—becoming wealthy in the process.

He said the 64-year-old Beck treated the union money as a loan, but the defense lawyer did not directly call it a loan.

"Beck took the money in a rather peculiar way... an informal way, and it was this informality that got him into this difficulty. These were the dealings of a self-confident, self-educated man. This is what brought about the well-known downfall of Mr. Beck," Dwyer said.

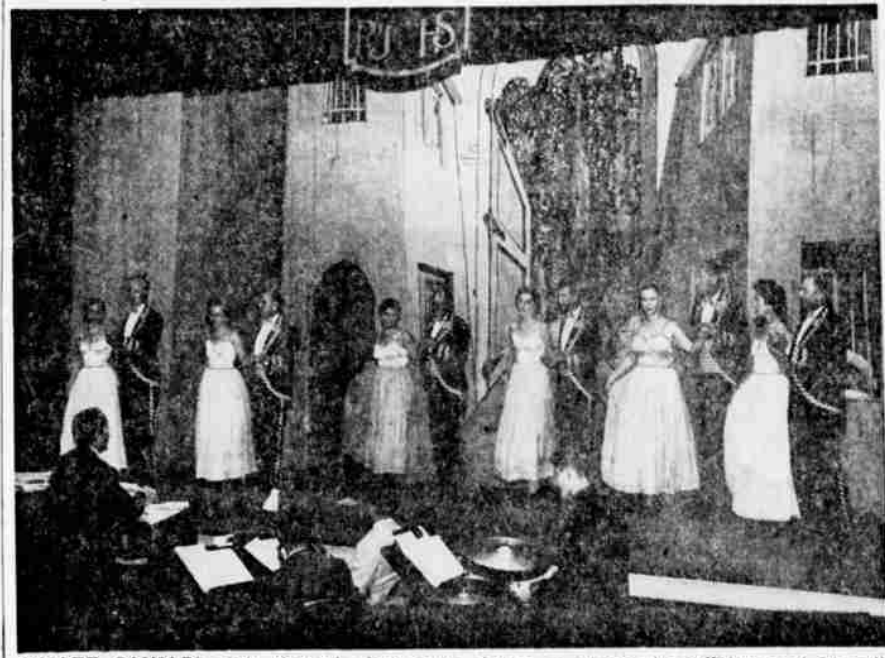

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Brucker Labels Russian Build-up As Blackmail

WELCH, W. Va. (AP)—Secretary of the Army Wilber M. Brucker said today that the aim of the Soviet Union build-up in capability for limited war is blackmail.

In an address prepared for a Veterans Day ceremony here, Brucker said Soviet propagandists insist that any local war inevitably would expand to worldwide proportions.

"Yet concurrently, the Soviets have strengthened their own capabilities for limited war. The Soviet bloc has more than eight million men under arms. The Soviet Union has some 500 submarines and 25,000 operational aircraft," he said.

"Soviet ground forces have been completely reorganized and re-equipped since World War II, and great improvements have been made in their mobility, their firepower, and their communications."

"The implied threat of their use is obviously calculated to blackmail the free nations into inaction."

Portland Boys Given Sentences On Robbery Count

PORTLAND (AP)—Two 16-year-old Portland boys were sentenced to prison for five years Monday.

Both had taken part in an armed robbery. Both had long records of law violation and defiance of authority.

Bruce Victor Jones, who has been at MacLaren School for Boys for such things as auto theft, being in an automobile accessories theft ring, and truancy, cried when Circuit Judge Virgil H. Langtry pronounced sentence.

Paul Russell Kraemer showed no emotion in the courtroom but on being taken to jail was abusive and obscene in his talk. His record for burglary goes back four years. He has spent 24 months at MacLaren school.

The two, along with Melvin Clarence Petersen, 19, who is awaiting sentence, robbed a bus driver of \$75 last August.

Langtry said rehabilitation efforts had been tried fully on the boys.

Local Miller's Store Not Affected By Dispute
EUGENE (AP)—Pickets appeared before Miller's Dept. Store in Eugene today, stemming from a labor dispute at Yakima, Wash.

A spokesman for the union said pickets from Retail Clerks Union, Local No. 631, Yakima and Wenatchee, Wash., had extended their picket lines Monday to include all 16 branch stores of the Miller Mercantile Co. in Oregon, Washington and Idaho.

The union contends the firm has refused to bargain collectively.

Joe Hayward, manager of the Eugene branch store, said he had no comment to make on the picket lines.

In Roseburg, Rod Nevue, Miller's manager, said he knew of no picketing planned at his store. He pointed out that the employees are not members of the Retail Clerks Union.

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Judge Redding Recommended For District Judge

PORTLAND (AP)—Appointment of Circuit Judge Charles W. Redding, Portland, to the U.S. District Court here was recommended Monday by the Oregon State Bar.

He would take bench seat left by the resignation of Judge Claude McCulloch.

The bar announced the endorsement after polling its members. Redding received 327 votes, 257 of them from members of the Multnomah County bar. Following him in preference were Arno H. Denecke, Portland, 213; Judge Alfred T. Sulmonetti, Portland, 202; and Judge Edward H. Howell, Canyon City, 198.

Howell was first choice among attorneys in the 2nd and 4th congressional districts.

Anthony Yturri, Ontario, placed sixth in the state with 150 votes and John F. Kilkenny, Pendleton, eighth with 135. Judge J. S. Bohannon, Tillamook, was ninth with 45.

All others named were from Portland.

There has been speculation the appointment may go to an Eastern Oregon man since both Judge Gus Solomon and Judge William G. East are from Western Oregon.

The President makes the appointment and the bar's preference vote is only one factor in his decision.
