

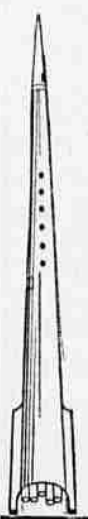
Flight Recorder Off During Crash

SEATTLE (AP) — A flight recorder was not working when a Boeing 707 jetliner crashed in Northern Snohomish County Oct. 19, the Civil Aeronautics Board said.

The CAB, quoted in Aviation Daily, said the flight crew failed to switch on the recorder, which investigators had hoped would shed light on the mishap.

The huge jet, on a training flight, crashed into the Stillaguamish River after undergoing a "violent maneuver" which caused three of its four engines to tear loose. Four men were killed and four injured.

It was reported that the Boeing Airplane Co. has ordered operation of the flight recorder on all future training flights.

Gov. Hatfield Would Accept Vice President Nomination

Gov. Mark Hatfield said Thursday he is not an active candidate for the vice presidency of the United States, but added it would be "very difficult to refuse if it were offered."

"I'm not anticipating it," Hatfield said, "but if the offer were made, I'd give it very careful con-

sideration."

"And," he added, "I'd probably find it very difficult to turn down."

The governor said he is not backing any specific candidate for the Republican nomination for president in the 1960 general election.

"I'm going to be neutral," he said, "because I feel the rank and file voter should make the decision in the primary election—without influence of any of our political figures."

Asked what he thought of GOP chances in the presidential election, Hatfield said, "I'm very optimistic about Republican chances."

"I don't know if the Republican party can pick up enough seats to control Congress, but I'm very optimistic about the presidential election possibilities," he declared.

Hatfield will tour several areas of the state with presidential candidate Gov. Nelson Rockefeller of New York this weekend.

Israel Coalition Set

JERUSALEM (AP) — Premier David Ben-Gurion is expected to form a three-party coalition government with an eight-vote majority in the Israeli Parliament.

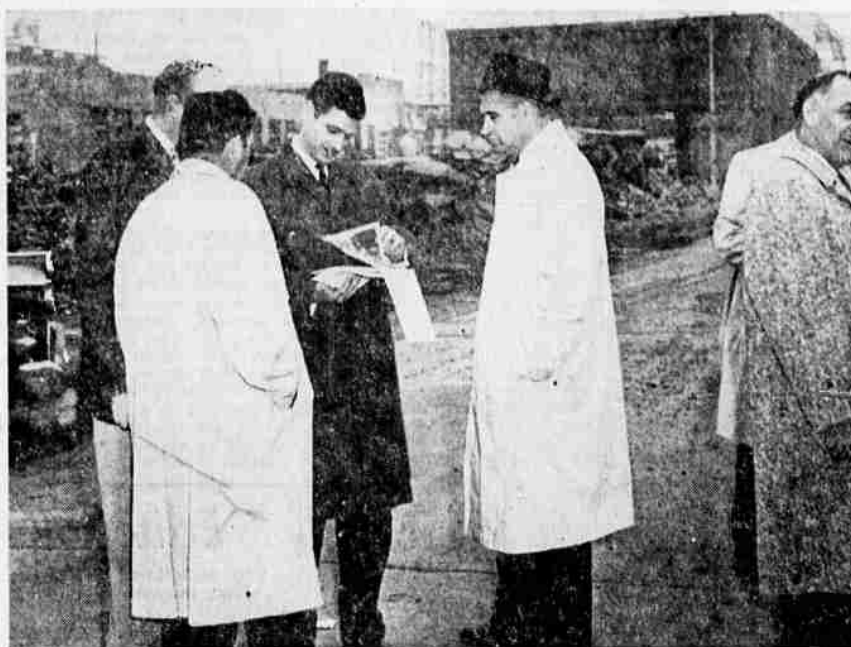

Roseburg Clean-up Program Impresses Governor; Pacific Plywood Plant Toured

"I'm tremendously impressed with the clean-up program being carried out here," Gov. Mark Hatfield said Thursday as he toured the center of the Aug. 7 Roseburg disaster area.

"And," the governor added, "I'm very happy to see the rebuilding program being carried on here."

"I feel the local officials and leaders have shown tremendous insight in this situation by working on a long-range reconstruction program instead of just working for rapid rebuilding of the area."

Hatfield said he didn't feel qualified to comment on the particular plan of famed architect Richard Neutra, but added he felt "any way which wood can be used through dramatic presentation to further the lumber industry is advantageous to the entire Pacific Northwest."

Following his tour of the disaster area, Hatfield, who had spoken on industry in Oregon, toured one of the major industries of the Roseburg area, Pacific Plywood Corp.

He took an extensive tour of the plant with Pacific Plywood officials William Forrest and Del McKay to see every product made at the Dillard plant.

Hatfield said he was very impressed with the plant, and the

many uses it finds for lumber from our Oregon forests. He refers to Pacific Plywood boss Forrest as, "one of our last real rugged individualists."

Following his tour of Pacific Plywood, the Governor attended a special dinner at the Four Winds Restaurant in Sutherlin for members of the 1958 Hatfield-for-Governor Committee.

All 41 members of the original committee were present.

A-Bomb Seen Peace Aid

WASHINGTON (AP) — The Prime Minister of Africa's Ivory Coast said here that possession of nuclear weapons by France would help assure world peace.

Felix Houphouët-Boigny said at the White House that his country and the 10 others in Africa which belong to the French community of nations all favor France having such weapons.

Virginians Integrate

FLOYD, Va. (AP) — The Floyd County School Board, acting under a federal judge's order, has assigned 13 Negroes to two all-white high schools. They will enter at the start of the second semester Jan. 25.

It will be the first public school integration in southwest Virginia.

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
