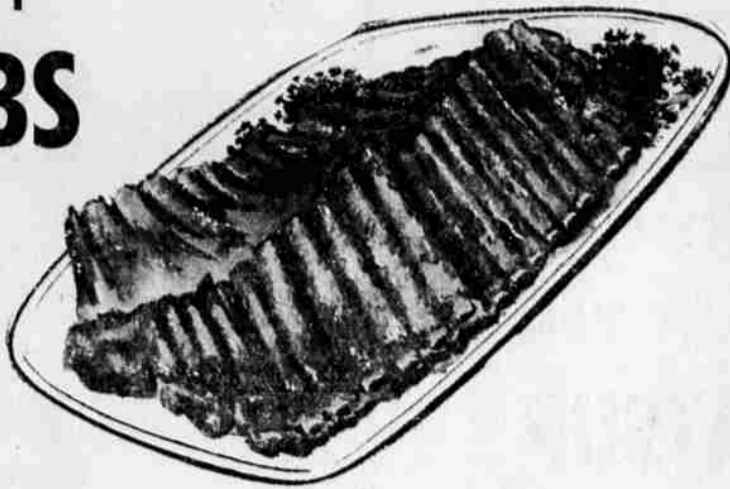

**Washington Agriculture Production Shows Gain**

OLYMPIA (AP) — Agriculture production in Washington last year was five per cent below the 1959 total, according to State Agriculture director Joe Dwyer.  
He set value of the 1960 output at \$602,176,000, and blamed the cost-price squeeze for the drop.  
Only two important crops—apples and potatoes—showed any gain in overcoming the cost-price problem, the director said.
