**Seashore Backers
Form State Group**

PORTLAND (AP) — Backers of the proposal to create an Oregon Dunes National seashore this week organized a statewide organization to boost the proposal.

James A. Mount, Portland, was named chairman of the group, which adopted the name Oregon Dunes National Seashore Committee.

A bill to create the park has been introduced in Congress by Sen. Maurine Neuberger, D-Ore. It would encompass the dunes area between Florence and Reedsport.

Dr. Sanford Topfer of the University of Oregon told the group the designation of the area as a national park would bring millions of tourist dollars to the state and make the dunes one of the nation's prime recreational attractions.

Daniel Burroughs, regional representative of the National Park Service, said that under Park Service Management the proposed 35,000-acre park would be put into one unit for maximum development.

Dan Malarky, former president of the Oregon Coast Association, urged public support for the proposal.

Among members named to the executive committee was Charles Collins, director of parks, Douglas County.

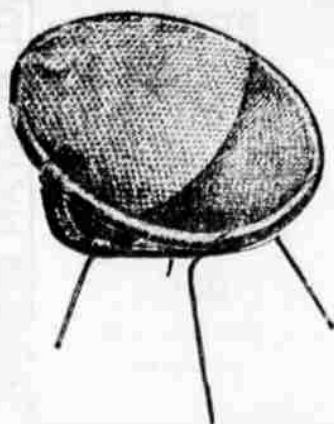
