Plaintiff asks award of Reedsport property, with Coos County property to defendant, and division of personal property. Claudette M. vs. Joseph F. Wolford. Married at Fortuna Calif., in November 1959. Cruelly charged. Custody of child and \$50 a month support asked by plaintiff. Shirley vs. Joseph Nelson. Married at Reno, Nev., Jan. 23, 1961. Cruelly charged. Plaintiff asks custody with \$50 support during pregnancy and custody with \$50 support of child after birth, and suit money. Phyllis vs. Charles Ostrander. Married Sept. 21, 1958 in Roseburg. Cruelly charged. Plaintiff asks custody of three minor children and \$35 a month for the support of each. Fourth child is of legal age. Plaintiff asks that defendant pay obligations and suit money, and that personal property division as designated be made.

Glenn A. vs. Flossie Elnetta Goodwin. Married in Douglas County March 5, 1955. Cruelly charged. Custody of two children asked by plaintiff. William A. vs. Donna B. Poland. Married at Reno, Nev., Oct. 29, 1955. Desertion charged. Plaintiff asks award of car and household furnishings.

Lawrence A. vs. Fayola M. De-Vault. Married June 26, 1948, at Steamboat Springs, Colo. Cruelly charged. Custody of three children asked by plaintiff, who also asks award of 1952 car and household furnishings.

Diane M. vs. Gerald R. Moffitt. Married at Sutherlin Oct. 6, 1959. Desertion charged. Plaintiff asks custody of child, \$35 a month support and suit money.
