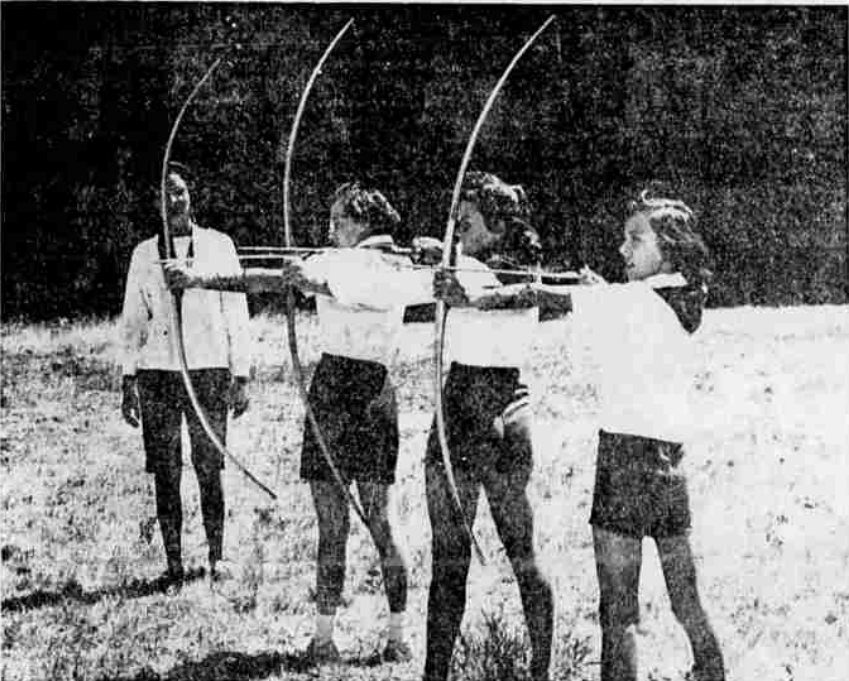

Jerry Barber Claims PGA Crown

CHICAGO (AP) — Jerry Barber of Los Angeles, a sawed-off little guy with a whittled-down magic putter and a tell-all card file, is the PGA golf champion today after firing a 67 and beating young Don January by one stroke in a par-busting 18-hole playoff at Olympia Fields Country Club.

Oldest PGA champion ever at 45 and one of the smallest at 5-5 and 137 pounds, the never-quit son of an Illinois farmer finally got the title he let slip away two years ago.

Barber, who said he got serious about golf at the age of 14 when he read of Bobby Jones' grand slam, did it with putting and a cardfile of Olympia Fields' North Course he made during practice rounds.

Course Charted — "I picked up the idea from Gene Andrews, a good amateur out our way, about three years ago," he said. "I pace off each course, chart it and it tells me to the yard just how far every point is from the green."

That kept him out of serious trouble all during the tournament. The putter put him up in the headlines. First, he pulled even with

the lean, lanky January on Sunday by sinking incredible putts on the last three holes.

Then, in the playoff Monday while another hot sun baked the rain-softened, 6,722-yard, par 35-35 70 course in Chicago's south suburbs, Jerry twice came from two strokes behind. He finally wrapped up his first major title when, after getting birdies on three of the previous five holes, he hit a pressure 3-iron shot out of a fairway trap to win on 18 feet of the cup on the last hole.

TIGARD (AP) — Lake Oswego beat Newport, 10-3 and Northeast Portland gained a 5-4 victory over Tigard in the opening round of the Babe Ruth state baseball tournament at Tigard Monday night.

Madison of Portland plays The Dalles tonight and Klamath Falls goes against Mt. Hood of Portland in the remaining two first round games.

Grosz Slated To Play In Canadian Grid Tilt

SPOKANE (AP) — Local gridiron fans will get their first hometown look at Canadian pro football Tuesday night when the Saskatchewan Roughriders tangle with the Calgary Stampeders in an exhibition game.

It will be the first pro game played here since the mid-'50's, when two National League teams met in a lackadaisical exhibition.

Joe Kapp, former California star, quarterback the Stampeders. Dave Grosz, a rookie from the University of Oregon, is being lined for the quarterback call in the Roughriders lineup. Don McKel, ex-University of Washington halfback, is a Saskatchewan rookie.

Portland Outfielder Freed

HONOLULU (AP) — William Wilson, 33, outfielder for Portland of the Pacific Coast League, was acquitted of a vagrancy charge Monday.

The prosecution said it lacked evidence.

Wilson was arrested July 28 after a hotel guard said he found him in a coconut tree on a hotel grounds.

The Portland club was in Honolulu to play a series with Hawaii at the time of Wilson's arrest.

Johnson And Manager Suspended At Portland

PORTLAND (AP) — The Portland Boxing Commission Monday suspended lightweight champion Harold Johnson and his business manager, Pat Oliveri.

Commission chairman Ben Harris said the action was taken because Johnson and Oliveri were not going through with a scheduled Aug. 11 return match between Johnson and Eddie Machen.

Johnson won a decision over Machen earlier this summer and their contract called for a rematch, Harris said.

The Portland commission sent notice of its action to National Boxing Association Headquarters in Cleveland, asking that group to recognize the Portland suspension.

In other action, the commission approved an Aug. 11 match between heavyweights Thad Spencer, Portland, and Tommy Fields, Los Angeles.

Jon Douglas Resumes Bid For Davis Berth

SOUTHAMPTON, N.Y. (AP) — Jon Douglas, fresh from his victory in the Pennsylvania grass-court championships, resumed his bid for a berth on the U.S. Davis Cup team today in the Meadow Club Invitation Tournament.

Douglas, who Monday defeated Frank Froehling, 6-2, 6-3, 6-1, in the final at Haverford, Pa., plays in a second-round match. The former Stanford quarterback drew a first-round bye.

Another victory in the Meadow Club event, a traditional stop on

the Eastern grass-court circuit, would virtually insure the Santa Monica, Calif., slugger a berth on the Davis Cup squad in its next American zone match.

The U.S. faces the survivor of this week's duel between Mexico and Morocco, Aug. 18-20.

Froehling, the 19-year-old sensation from Coral Gables, Fla., joins the Meadow Club field as its third-seeded player, along with second-seeded Jack Frost, Monterey, Calif., and fourth-seeded Dennis Ralston, Bakersfield, Calif.
