

Jet Pilots Can Start Applying Now For Space Docking Project Jobs.

WASHINGTON (AP) — Jet test pilots who would like to be astronauts in the Gemini space docking project can start applying now. Five to 10 of them will be selected by fall.

The Gemini project is another step in the process of sending a three-man Apollo spacecraft to the moon and back, possibly by 1966.

The National Aeronautics and Space Administration said the new astronauts will support the seven-man project Mercury team in Mercury space capsule operations and will join the seven in piloting the two-man Gemini spacecraft.

NASA said Robert R. Gilruth of the Manned Spacecraft Center at Houston will receive applications until June 1.

The first unmanned orbital flight of a two-place Gemini capsule is planned for next year. In

the docking maneuver will get its first space test.

Docking involves rendezvous in orbit with another space vehicle sent up separately. The idea is that a separately orbited engine

could provide the extra thrust needed to get an Apollo capsule to the moon.

The space agency said Apollo flight crews will be selected from the seven current astronauts, the

five to 10 to be chosen by fall and a third group of astronauts that probably will be selected in the late stages of the Apollo mooncraft development program.

Candidates for the Gemini project must be experienced jet test pilots, younger than 35 and no taller than 6 feet.

They must hold a college degree in the physical or biological sciences or in engineering. Also,

they must have attained experimental flight test status either through the military services, the aerospace industry or NASA, or be graduates of a military test pilot school.

Complaint

State of Oregon, represented and acting by Director of Veterans Affairs vs. Charles I. and Shirley Zimmerman. Plaintiff asks award of \$3,738.33 plus interest, attorney fees and other costs or foreclosure mortgage on Douglas County property. Plaintiff alleges defendants defaulted in connection with promissory note executed Nov. 5, 1958, at Reedsport, in which the indebtedness was secured by the property.

Kency Credit Service, Inc. vs. Willard Peter and Mary J. Jurgensen. Plaintiff asks judgment for sums of \$18.92, \$115.30, promissory note balance in sum of \$623.29, plus attorney fees, interest amounts and costs on assigned accounts.

James Kolb vs. State Industrial Accident Commission. Plaintiff asks re-opening of his claim and award of compensation for permanent partial disability equal to 45 per cent loss function of an arm for unscheduled injuries. The plaintiff was injured Sept. 27, 1960 while employed by Smitty's Logging. He was struck on the back and leg by a falling tree. The commission closed the account with an award of compensation equal to 10 per cent loss function of an arm for unscheduled injuries.

Marian L. Jeffers vs. Samuel F. Jeffers. Plaintiff awarded \$63 as judgment for accrued attorney fees due to plaintiff based on order of court issued Feb. 27, 1962.

Thomas Mallory and Laura Mallory vs. Sen Sin Ching. Judgment order on mandate of the Oregon Supreme Court following the Supreme Court's reversal of judgment in favor of defendant. Defendant awarded \$270 plus interest to recover costs and disbursements.

The court granted a voluntary nonsuit against the defendant Herbert Schoenbrod on motion of the plaintiff and awarded the plaintiff judgment of \$1,416.85 plus interest, costs and disbursements against defendant Heath as amount asked in complaint.

Douglas County vs. Milton Herbert, dba Herbert Lumber Co. and Arline Herbert, his wife. An order denying motion by plaintiff for new trial and setting Monday, April 23, at 9:30 a.m. as time set for a Courthouse hearing in distribution of judgment proceeds.

Douglas L. Logan vs. William P. Wampler and Diamond Lake Lumber Co.; William Siegel vs. same defendants; Lawrence W. Apud vs. same defendants. Based on stipulation by parties indicating cases compromised, all three related suits dismissed with prejudice and without costs to any party.

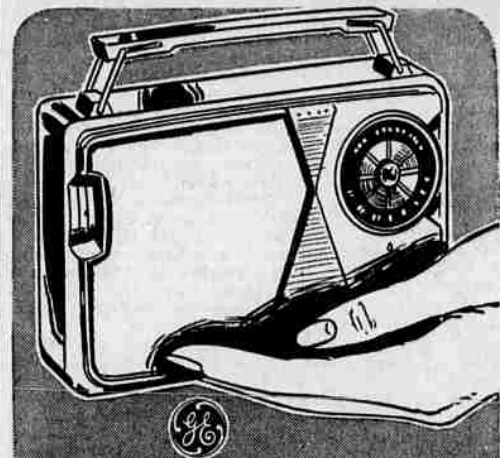

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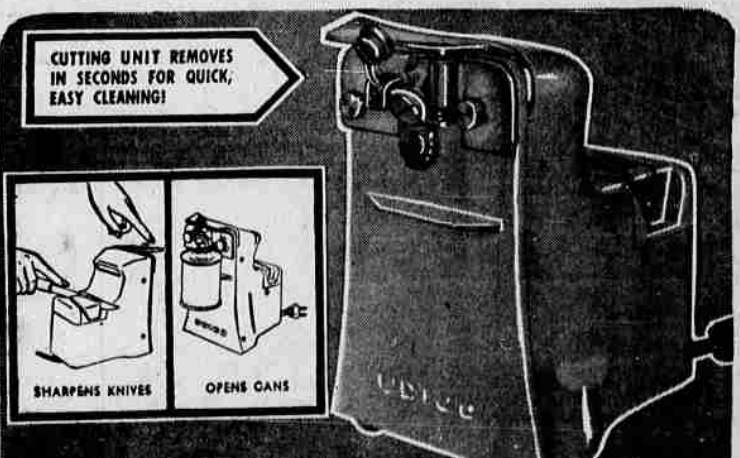
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
