

CAUSE FOR THOUGHT

Earlier this month federal employees in this area received a booklet, printed in colors, supporting the Kennedy program for health insurance through social security. It presented the many arguments being used to support the medicare proposal. It concluded with a section urging the recipient to "write your senators and congressman to pass the urgently needed King-Anderson bill."

The booklet gave no indication of its source. It violated Oregon's corrupt practices act by such failure. According to a federal employee, anyone employed through Civil Service would be guilty of violation of the Hatch Act if he followed the suggestion contained in the booklet and mailed a letter either for or against a piece of controversial legislation — one that has developed into quite a political party issue.

The booklet aroused considerable controversy. Where did it come from? Who sponsored it?

But the most important question is, where did the sponsors of this booklet get the mailing list of federal employees?

Council Is Sponsor

The identity of the sponsor of this booklet has been learned. The publicity was prepared and mailed, it is reported, through the National Council of Senior Citizens, headquartered in New York.

But where did the council get its list of federal employees?

That question, I am informed, is under investigation. If this piece of literature is, as has been indicated, a product from the National Council of Senior Citizens, it must have been paid for from the council's treasury, or by membership from elderly citizens, most of whom don't have money to waste.

But the cost of sending this literature to federal employees (and probably several hundred thousand at least) were so distributed was a complete waste, if, as has been stated, federal employees are barred by the Hatch Act from participating in a controversial political issue.

Certainly there can be no question but that there are good arguments on both sides of this medicare squabble. The arguments both for and against need study and analysis. Instead, the matter is being pushed on a basis of emotion.

The American Medical Association is very vigorously opposing the President's plan. Instead it favors, at least in part, the Kerr-Mills Act, already in effect in some states.

The Kerr-Mills Act puts medical assistance to the aged on a foundation of need, ability to pay, etc. But it also provides for payment of sort to the doctors. The King-Anderson Bill, however, provides financial help for hospitalization and medicines, but nothing for the doctor's services. Does that fact influence the medical organization in its position? On the other hand, how valuable is a plan that pays only part of the hospital bill and nothing for the doctor's services. Are doctors expected to work for nothing?

Economies Involved

Then, there is a great deal of misunderstanding with regard to economy involved in the President's proposal, in my opinion.

The President's medicare bill finds much support in the ranks of organized labor. But the nation's workers must pungle up a good many millions of dollars to provide the money needed to pay for the care of people now getting relief, while, at the same time, building up a credit for themselves in later years.

A good many workers feel that they're getting something for nothing in the Social Security program. Doesn't the employer pay half? Who cares what the "profit-grabbing" employer pays?

The fact is, however, that most employers are in a position to pass on the cost of Social Security. They add their tax and benefit costs to the price of the commodity or service with which they are connected. The higher price of commodities and services enters into inflation. Thus the worker actually pays the whole bill in the long run. In fact, he usually pays more through commodity purchase than if taxed direct, because business mark-ups are by percent rather than by dollars.

If the Social Security rate is boosted again to meet the cost of Medicare, will the inflationary result cost the senior citizen more than would a policy with an established health insurance organization?

In any event, why should Senior Citizen money be wasted for printing and circulating bulletins to people who would violate the law by following instructions, and how did they get the mailing list in the first place?

Tough General Contends SE Asia Nations Won't Go To Communists

SAIGON, South Viet Nam—Gen. Paul D. Harkins is a square-jawed, sandy-haired four-star general who commands U. S. forces both in Thailand and South Viet Nam. He takes the firm view that the Communists are not going to be allowed to take over either country.

In the last few months there has been evidence to support what otherwise might be undue optimism in a country 65 per cent controlled in whole or in part by Communist Viet Cong guerrillas.

What gains there have been against the Viet Cong may be attributed to two factors—the helicopter which transports government troops and their American instructors swiftly, and the strategic hamlet which is hoped ultimately will cut Viet Cong lines of supply and communication and at the same time teach their inhabitants the basic values of true democracy.

In recent weeks, Viet Cong attacks forced the closing of two rubber plantations, one of them with a production of 1,000 tons annually. Statistics may be misleading but a glance at a few of them illustrate the enormous task facing the government of President Ngo Dinh Diem and General Harkins.

In the past year, Viet Cong attacks, acts of sabotage or kidnappings have been occurring at the rate of about 500 per month. It is estimated that Viet Cong kidnaps or kills at least six local government representatives each day.

One thousand school classrooms have been closed down. Out of a total of 3,000 local health centers, more than 600 have been forced to close.

The malaria eradication program has been hampered seriously by the kidnapping or killing of anti-malaria teams.

Bridges and the coastal railway have been special Viet Cong targets. It is estimated that at least one bridge a day is damaged or destroyed.

U. S. To Explode N-Bomb Monday

WASHINGTON (AP)—The United States plans to set off a nuclear burst at least 125 miles higher—and probably much higher—over the Pacific Monday night.

The Atomic Energy Commission announced the date this week, saying the blast would be triggered in the Johnston Island area south-west of Hawaii.

The device will have the explosive force of about a million tons of TNT.

The test was scheduled for between 11 p.m. Monday and 2:30 a.m. Tuesday Hawaiian Standard Time—4 a.m. to 7:30 a.m. Eastern Standard Time.

If the test is delayed because of weather or technical problems beyond that 3½-hour period, it will be put off to a later date.

More Signers Needed On Vets Bonus Petition

ALBANY (UPI)—Only 6,000 signatures statewide have been obtained for the initiative petition for a Korean veterans bonus, Charles Draper, Albany, state commander of the American Legion, said this week.

The petition must have 55,000 names to place the measure on the November ballot.

There have been 3,000 signatures obtained in Linn County. Final deadline is July 5.

Korean veterans eligible would be those serving between June 25, 1950 and July 27, 1953 inclusive.
