Complaints
Ray M. Schoch vs. Eva M. and Wayne Corley. Plaintiff asks interlocutory decree ordering the defendant, Eva M. Corley, to pay plaintiff full amount alleged due in connection with contract executed March 20, 1961, involving Douglas County property or foreclosing the property. The property is described as lot 6 in the Philippi Acres of Douglas County.

B. A. Young, S. J. Cooper, L. E. Gilliam, A. A. Young and Cora Young vs. Albert Decker and Pete Decker dba Decker Logging Co. and James Dew. Plaintiff asks award of \$50,000 plus costs and disbursements. Plaintiffs allege that defendants on Oct. 2, 1960, came upon mining property owned by plaintiffs and caused five buildings to be destroyed along with their contents and caused damage to a watersupply system for the mining property. The mining property involved, according to the complaint, is located in sections 33 and 34, township 29 south, range 2 west, Willamette Meridian, Douglas County.

Isabelle Jane Curry, Edith Florence Curry and Lulu Ann Curry vs. K. R. Linder, Max L. Seitz and William R. True. Plaintiff asks award of \$2,150 to apply on alleged delinquent principal and interest installments through June 15, 1962, in connection with real property contract executed Feb. 1, 1961. The complaint indicates defendants are co-partners in Pay Less Petroleum Products. The property involved is two lots in Railroad Addition to Roseburg. Plaintiff also asks attorney fees, costs and disbursements.

Dismissals
North Roseburg Sanitary District vs. Clifford and Blanche Aten et al. On motion of plaintiff, case dismissed with prejudice and without cost to either party.

Judgments
Howard Cooper Corp. vs. Umpqua Logging Co., and Dean Ellis, Fred Hoefke and Charles Mack as the state Tax Commission. A judgment for plaintiff to recover from defendant Umpqua Logging Co. and intervenor Paulus F. McKee, trustee in bankruptcy of the estate of Umpqua Logging Co. in bankruptcy, \$772.50 as attorney fees, plus costs and disbursements.
Howard Cooper Corp. vs. Funderburk Construction Co. et al. A judgment for plaintiff to recover from defendant Funderburk Construction Co. and intervenor Paulus McKee, trustee in the bankruptcy of estate of Funderburk Construction Co., bankrupt, \$1,702.50 for attorney fees, plus costs and disbursements.

Clarence Johnson vs. state Industrial Accident Commission. A judgment that plaintiff's claim be referred back to defendant and that a Sept. 20, 1961, order be cancelled and that defendant provide for plaintiff such medical treatment as his condition shall warrant and that plaintiff be restored to temporary total disability as of termination date until further order of commission.

Robert H. Savage vs. Clifford M. Whorton and Terrence Eldon Whorton. Based on stipulation of parties, case is dismissed with prejudice and without costs to either party.

W. F. Schell vs. Delmar Roles, Dale R. Roles and Duane Roles, dba Roseburg Shingle Co. Based on jury trial verdict in favor of defendant, a judgment given ordering plaintiff to pay costs and disbursements in the suit.
Harold Harrison vs. state Industrial Accident Commission. A judgment awarding to plaintiff permanent partial disability equal to 45 per cent loss function of a left leg and 25 per cent loss function of an arm for unselected disability.

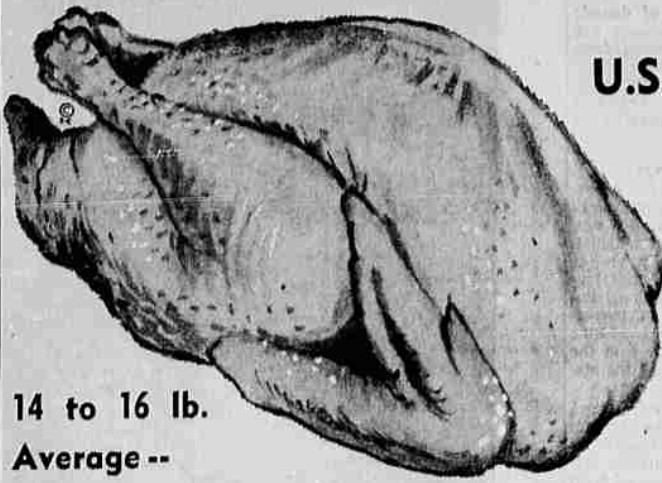
Decree
Vera M. White vs. Jay and Gladys Alford, and State of Oregon, through the state Tax Commission. Based on defendants' default, a decree for plaintiff in amount of \$3,979.86 plus interest, plus attorney fees and other costs of foreclosing property described in the Hermann Addition, Myrtle Creek. In connection with this case, the action was dismissed as to the defendant, state Tax Commission, with prejudice and without costs to any party.
