## Graham's Campaign Reported A Success

CHICAGO (UPI) — Evangelist Billy Graham left this week with statistics showing his 19-sermon Chicago Crusade was a success.

"I preached to more people in that period than in any other two and one half weeks of my life," Graham said.

Graham sidestepped a question about the relative success of the crusade, commenting: "If one person in this city has changed his way of living, I would say Chicago is a better place to live."

But the figures for the revivals, which started May 30 and ended with a huge meeting in Soldier Field Sunday afternoon, were impressive.

The Protestant evangelist said more than 700,000 persons attended the sermons, nearly 16,500 of these made "decisions for Christ," and the crusade grossed about \$719,000.

Graham, tanned and appearing slightly tired, also told a news conference before flying to North Carolina that he almost fainted in the heat Sunday.

I can remember when I thought I was going to faint. The Kleig lights were right there in front of us putting out tremendous heat. For 10 or 15 seconds everything went black."

## Canadian Election Concerns Maurine

WASHINGTON (UPI) — Sen. Maurine B. Neuberger, D - Ore., recently voiced concern over the Canadian election result.

She said in a statement "it is tragic that Canadian leadership will be subject to the dictation of the irresponsible Social Credit party which now holds the balance of power."

Mrs. Neuberger said the elections mean for the "sorely pressed Northwest lumber industry... the end to the hope that the Canadian government will move to lessen the competitive men over their American counterparts."

She also said the election means there will be no ratification of the Columbia River project in the "foreseeable future" and that "we will be forced to adopt alternative programs for the development of Columbia River power."

## House Approves New Sugar Bill

WASHINGTON (UPI) — The House this week passed a bill that would increase American growers' share of the nation's lucrative sugar market but force the United States to continue paying premium prices for cheap foreign sugar. The vote was 319-72.

The bill now goes to the Senate where administration forces will attempt to revamp it. It would overhaul and extend for five years tight government controls which have regulated sugar marketing in the United States for 25 years. Existing controls expire July 1.

The administration favors the increase in marketing quotas for domestic growers. But it wants imports placed on a competitive first come, first served basis. Instead, the bill would continue to parcel them out through quotas which insure above market prices for the chosen foreign suppliers.
