Circuit Court

Complaint

Russell R. and Geraldine M. Lee vs. Delbert B. Blanchard dba Del's Building Supply, and Allied Concord Finance Co. Plaintiff asks decree rescinding contract, note and mortgage in a case involving an instrument executed April 7, 1962, between the plaintiffs and defendant, Blanchard, in which defendant, according to complaint, was to build a structure and furnish materials for the structure, the plaintiff agreeing to pay \$1 down and the balance of \$4,999 when the contract was completed and the materials furnished. Allied Concord Finance Co., plaintiff states, was to finance plaintiffs during construction with an understanding that plaintiffs wanted refinancing through FHA or GI loans at completion of the project. Plaintiff claims defendant Blanchard breached the contract by failing to perform the contract according to terms, conditions and specifications, alleging the structure does not meet FHA minimum property standards and that materials and workmanship did not meet contract requirements. Plaintiff asks decree awarding the structure, materials and other items placed on the property to the defendant, together with fee title to lot 26, Herman's Second Sub-division, Douglas County.

Appeal Dismissed
A memorandum opinion by Judge Don H. Sanders in the matter of the widening and realignment of Plat K Road No. 75 in Douglas County in regard to a motion by the district attorney seeking order to dismiss an appeal in this case on grounds that a timely petition for damages was not filed by appellants as required by law. Judge Sanders ordered the dismissal, ruling that appellants waived their rights by failing to file a petition for damages within the time allowed by statute.

Default Judgment, Decree
State Industrial Accident Commission vs. Roy W. Barnhart, dba Barnhart Construction Co. A judgment declaring defendant in default and ordering plaintiff to recover from defendant \$87.05 for contributions due under the Workmen's Compensation Law, plus interest and other costs, decreeing that plaintiff has valid liens on defendant's personal property described as a 1957 station wagon and ordering that the liens be foreclosed with proceeds to be applied to plaintiff's costs and disbursements and to payment of plaintiff's judgment and decree.

Appeal
In the matter of the widening and realignment of North Fork Smith River Rd. No. 48-A, Melvin W. and Martha E. Holmes have filed notice of appeal to the Circuit Court for Douglas County from a decision of the Douglas County Court of July 13, which denied their claim for damages.
