Mr. and Mrs. A. F. Micelli are back at their home here, following the last three days in Portland attending to business.

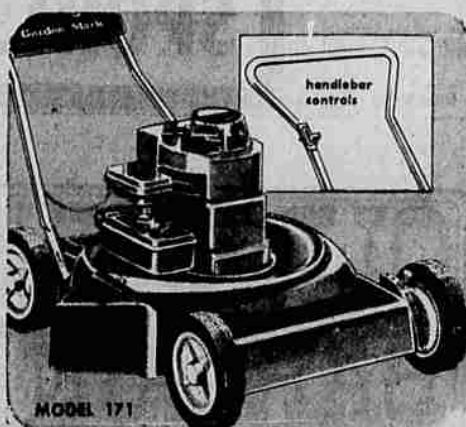
