

## Pearson Will Ask Nuclear Warheads

OTTAWA (UPI)—Liberal leader Lester B. Pearson Monday became Canada's 14th prime minister and immediately said he would acquire nuclear warheads for the nation's armed forces. He pledged the "friendliest possible" relations with the United States.

The Nobel Peace Prize-winning diplomat, who will be 66 Tuesday, took the oath of office at the bedside of Governor-general George Vanier. Vanier is recovering from a minor heart attack suffered the day after the April 8 election which gave the Liberals 130 members in the 265-seat House of Commons.

With Pearson were the members of the new Liberal cabinet which will manage the country's affairs in the days ahead. They too were sworn in by Vanier.

Pearson and his ministers appeared at Government House shortly after outgoing Prime Minister John Diefenbaker paid a final call to complete the resignation of his defeated Conservative administration.

Diefenbaker, 67, a prairie lawyer who assumed power in June, 1957, will remain as opposition leader in the new 28th Parliament, leading 93 Conservative members.

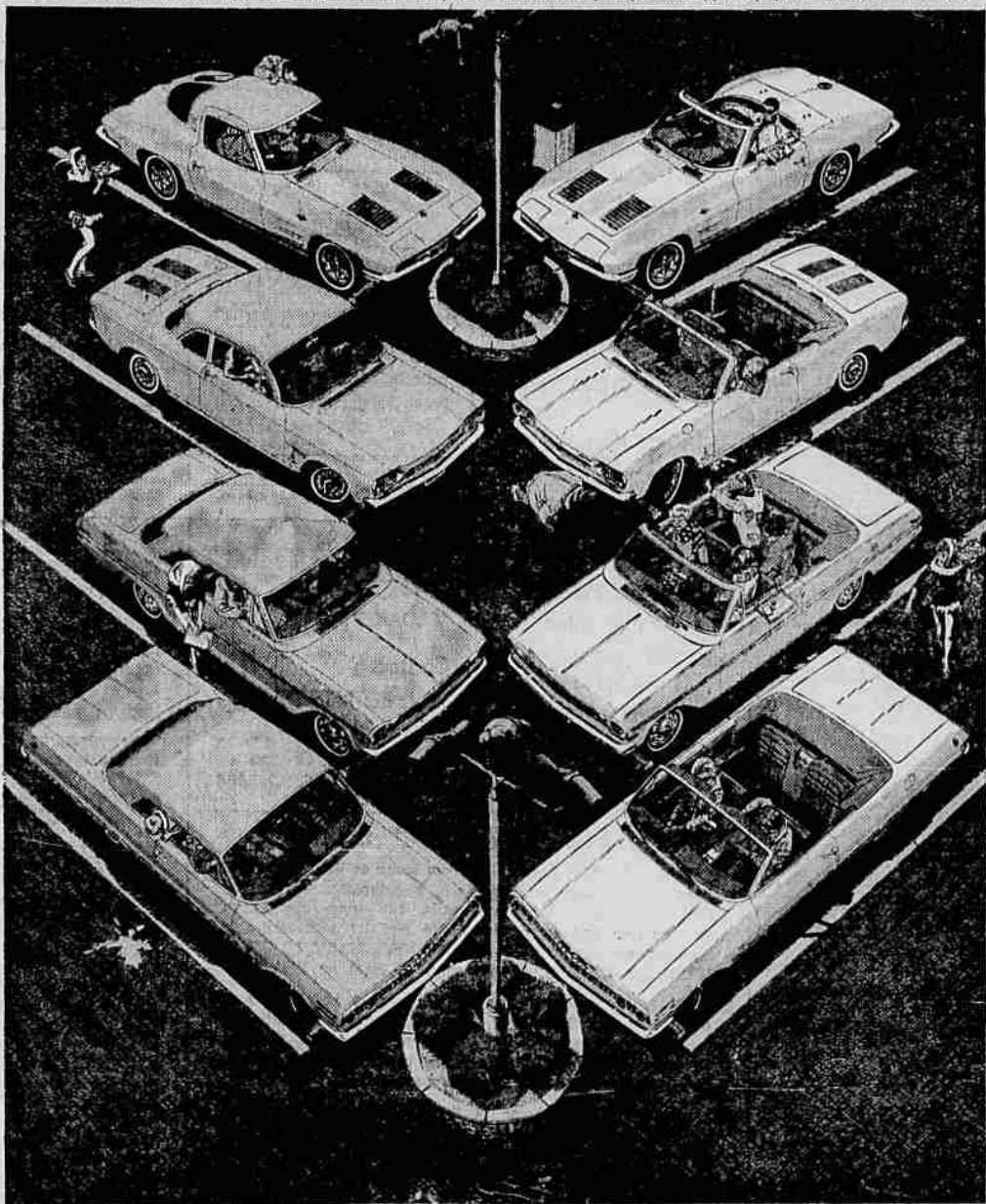
