Suicide Prevention Plan Is Proposed For Oregon

CORBETT, Ore. (UPI)—A California theology professor has suggested a suicide prevention center in Oregon serviced by a round-the-clock answering staff of clergymen.

Dr. Howard J. Clinebell Jr. told the 6th annual Mental Health Workshop that Los Angeles had such a center and there was a small, but effective, one in Chicago.

He said its only expense was a small advertisement in the newspaper listing a telephone number to be called by those in need of help. He said clergymen, scheduled to answer the number day or night, then are able to follow up the calls.

"Ministers are in a unique position as an identifier of presuicidal signs and other mental health symptoms," he said.

Dr. Clinebell is associate professor of pastoral counseling at Southern California School of Theology.

102,956 Public Employees In State

WASHINGTON (UPI)— Oregon had 102,956 public employees as of last October, the Bureau of the Census said Tuesday.

Of these, 21,665 worked for the federal government, 27,492 for the state and 53,799 for local governments.

The report said 38,096 states and local government employees had jobs in education with 29,017 in local school systems.

Oregon had 372 state and local government employees for each 10,000 population. Highest proportion among the 50 states was 405 in Wyoming and lowest was 261 in Arkansas. National average was 320.
